Re: Varsity vs. JV Volleyball Match Clarifications

The purpose of this memo is to clarify the rules and regulations regarding Volleyball Matches between two schools where a Varsity team is playing a Junior Varsity (JV) team.

Should this occur, the contest should be played as a Varsity match with a best three out of five games determining the winner. Officials should be paid the Varsity Match Fee by the host school for this contest.

For the school putting its Varsity team on the court, the contest is to be counted as a match towards their regular season **Varsity Match Limitations of 20.**

For the school putting its JV team on the court, the contest is to be counted as a match towards their seasons **Junior Varsity (JV) Match Limitations of 17.**
