

2020-2021 NMAA STATE SOCCER CHAMPIONSHIP INFORMATION

General Information:

- All championship contests must follow COVID safe guidelines as outlined and approved by the Governor's Office, Department of Health, Public Education Department and NMAA.
- You are allowed 22 uniformed players on the roster and up to two managers. Rosters must updated and finalized on MaxPreps by Sunday, April 4th, 2021 by 10:00 AM.
- Rosters may not be changed once the tournament has started unless an injury occurs. At that time, a doctor's note will be required if a change to the roster in needed.
- Eight teams (Class 4A-5A) and four teams (Class A-3A) will advance from the regular season to the post season. Quarterfinals and semifinals will be played at the higher seed or neutral site.

- Host school/site location and county color will determine the opportunity for spectator attendance. Check with the host site for ticket information and availability.
- Overnight travel is not permitted. Contest location and times will be determined based on school match-ups and seeding outcomes.

Finals @ UNM:

- An athletic trainer will be on site at UNM. If a school trainer is attending, they must have a NMAA Athletic Trainer All-Access Pass in order to receive complimentary entrance into the tournament.
- Teams may not warm up on the game field until 30 minutes prior to game time. All teams
 may use the field in between Robertson Field and the indoor football facility for additional
 warm up time.
- Locker rooms are not available. Restrooms are available.

- Teams are required to bring in their own drink containers and will also be provided with a
 water re-fill station in the team bench area. Athletes are not to share any beverage items.
- Tickets can be purchased online only. Please use the following link <u>NMAA State</u> Soccer Tickets
- UNM will be charging \$5.00 for parking. Anyone, including coaches and participants, not in a school vehicle or a bus will be charged.
- Due to seating capacity restrictions, complimentary access to the facility will be given to administrators only. All other (including soccer coaches and officials) must purchase a ticket to attend the event.
- At the conclusion of the contest, awards will be presented and teams are asked to immediately disperse. Social distancing and COVID safe practices to the greatest extent possible will be observed during awards presentations.
