





This will come via a minimum of ten \$1,000 scholarships that will be distributed to graduating seniors in an effort to provide even more support to the youth of our state.

Each year, the NMAA Foundation receives between 200 and 300 scholarship applications. On average, 18-20 students are selected from this pool as scholarship recipients. The Together We Rise program will ensure that approximately 35 students receive financial support from the NMAA Foundation in 2022-2023 to pursue their college aspirations.

The application deadline for the "Together We Rise" and all other NMAA Foundation scholarships is February 1, 2023. Recipients will be selected soon thereafter and each student will be honored at the 2022 NMAA State Basketball Championships.




