## **Financial Terms**

### **2022 Western Sky Community Care Cross Country Championships**

(1) **Admission.** \$10.00 for adults and \$5.00 for students/seniors/military. Children under 5 years of age will not be required to pay admission. All ticket will be digital and must be purchased in advance. There will be no on-site ticket sales.

### **Meet Regulations**

(1) **Teams.** A team shall be composed of five (5) to seven (7) runners. Schools that enter fewer than five runners, and schools who have fewer than five runners finish the race, shall not be eligible for team honors. Individual contestants from such schools, however, may earn individual awards.

(2) **Starting Positions.** The starting position for each team at the 2022 Western Sky Community Care State Cross Country Championships shall be determined by the team's finish at their district meet. Individuals will be placed with other individual qualifiers.

(3) **Meet Timing.** Clyde Neff will time the 2022 Western Sky Community Care State Cross Country Championships. Bib timers will be used to time each racer. Results will be available online following the completion of each race.

## **State Championships Policies**

(1) **Administration and Management.** All State Championships shall be conducted in accordance with the policies established by the NMAA Board of Directors and shall be under the control, direction, and supervision of the NMAA Office.

(2) **Enforcement of Rules & Policies.** Participating schools shall adhere to all regulations and policies governing the NMAA State Cross Country Championships.

(3) **Passes/Complementary List.** 2022 Western Sky Community Care State Cross Country Championships Passes, NMAA VIP Passes, and NMAA State Championships Media Passes ONLY, will be honored at state championship events. Individuals who are on the complementary list will also be admitted with a photo ID.

(4) **Signs and/or Banners.** The display of signs, banners, placards, or similar items at the state championships is permitted, provided:

- They are in good taste and reflect good sportsmanship in their message and use.
- They reflect identification and encouragement to participants and their school, and make no reference to the oppositions school, individuals, or community.
- They are not displayed on the course, or in a manner which interferes with the runners.
- They do not obstruct the view of participants or spectators.
- They are not safety hazards.
- They do not represent a conflict of interest with any NMAA sponsor.
