

## **Meet Registration Memo**

If you are hosting a meet during the 2023 Season, the Meet Registration Form must be completed prior to your meet. If you would like your meet to be posted to the Meet Schedule on the NMAA Powerlifting website, please select the "Make Meet Public" when prompted.

## Things to Consider:

- Public Meets will be posted on the Meet Schedule tab which will allow schools to contact the host for availability.
- Coaches Contacts can be found under the "Coaches Contact List" on the website. Monitor this often as this will be updated as schools decide to participate throughout the year.
- You do not need to know who your Head Judge and/or Platform Judges are at the time of meet registration.
  - We are currently compiling a list of Head Judges (Meet Officials) by region who are willing to facilitate your meet and will be posted on the website when complete.
  - Remember for your meet to be sanctioned as a State Qualifier you must have a Head
    Judge (Meet Official) present.
    - \*2023 Only If a Head judge is not available two participating Head Coaches who have completed the necessary requirements can fill this roll in a (Dual, Tri, Quad, or Invite).
- Your platform judges (Chief, Side, Side) 3 per platform can be any individual who has completed the 2023 NMAA Powerlifting Rules Test located in DragonFly which will open following the rules clinic.
  - Please ensure that one week prior to the meet that all platform judges for your meet have taken the NMAA rules book test through DragonFly so that we can assign in DragonFly.
