



2024 NB3 State Golf Championships presented by Realty One of New Mexico

Class 5A

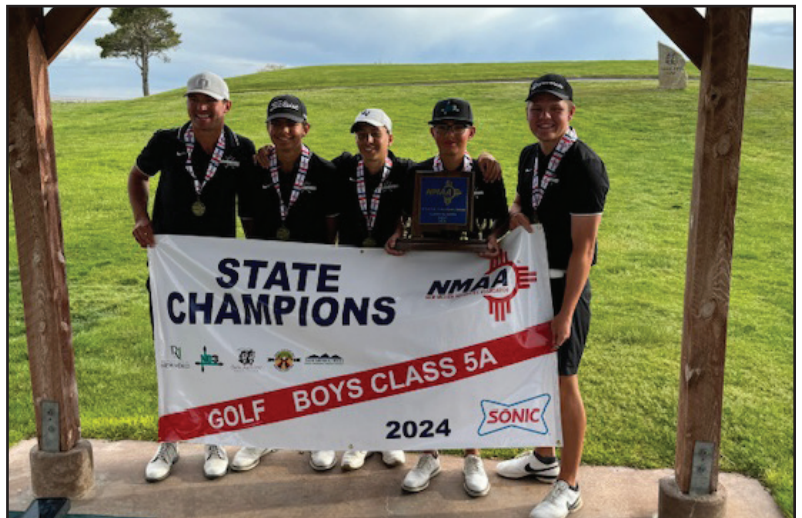
Girls

For the second time in four years, Piedra Vista finished the season on top. The Piedra Vista girls won the 2024 NB3 Foundation State Golf Championships presented by Realty One of New Mexico with a two-day total of 682, beating second place La Cueva by five shots. Piedra Vista built up a 14-shot lead after day one and held off the Bears on the final day at the Twin Warriors Golf Club located on the Santa Ana Pueblo. Alamogordo finished third in the team standings. Individually, Piedra Vista Annie Yost posted a bogey-free final round to win top medalist honors with a 145 total, winning by six strokes. West Mesa's Alyssa Rodriguez and Eleanor Warden finished tied for second with a 151 total.



Boys

The Volcano Vista Hawks won their first ever boys golf title with a two-day total of 610 at the 2024 NB3 Foundation State Golf Championships presented by Realty One of New Mexico. The Hawks posted the low round team total on both days at the Twin Warriors Golf Club on the Santa Ana Pueblo. Volcano Vista was nine shots better than second place La Cueva. Alamogordo finished third. Individually, La Cueva senior Jake Yrene went back-to-back winning his second straight 5A title by two strokes over Volcano Vista freshman JJ Botello. Yrene finished with a two-day total of 146.



Class 4A

Girls

For the fourth year in a row, Albuquerque Academy is the top girls team in Class 4A golf. The Chargers won the 2024 NB3 Foundation State Golf Championships presented by Realty One of New Mexico with a two-day total of 654, beating second place Kirtland Central by 27 shots. Lovington and Deming tied for third. Individually, Belen standout Rylee Salome won her third straight state title at the Santa Ana Golf Club. The junior posted a bogey free final round of 68 to contribute to her two-day total of 144. Salome finished with a nine-shot victory over Academy's Anya Parasher who finished second.



Boys

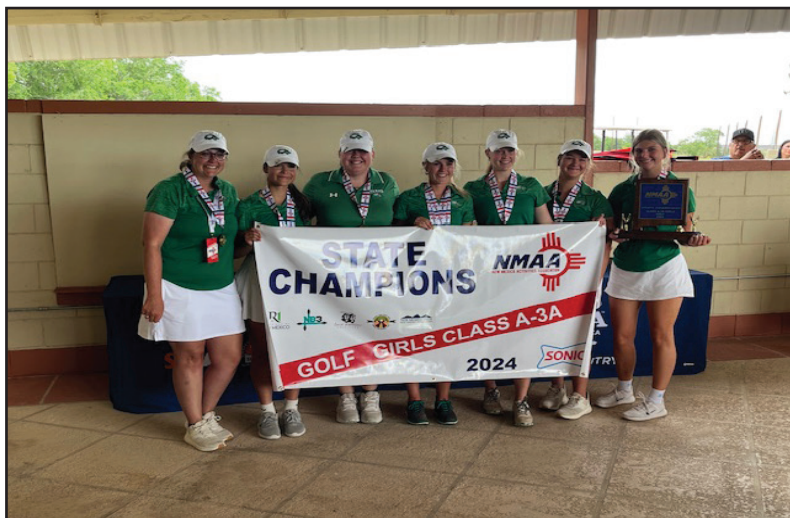
Albuquerque Academy made it a Charger sweep as the boys took home the Class 4A crown for the third time in four years. Albuquerque Academy won the 2024 NB3 Foundation State Golf Championships presented by Realty One of New Mexico with a total of 615. St. Pius X was second with 623 and Kirtland Central was third with 638. Individually, Skyler Woods of Kirtland Central took home his first state title with a total of 138 after two days at the Santa Ana Golf Club. Academy senior Clark Sonnenberg was two shots back in second place.



Class A-3A

Girls

Texico came from behind in the final round to win the Class A-3A blue trophy at the 2024 NB3 Foundation State Golf Championships presented by Realty One of New Mexico. The Wolverines finished the two rounds at the New Mexico Tech Golf Course in Socorro with a total of 792, six shots ahead of second place Socorro. It's the first team title for Texico's program. Individually, Texico's Liz Elam had the low round on the final day, shooting an 82, to win medalist honors with a 170 total. Elam was six shots better than Santa Fe Prep's Jazmin Leardsakulphasuk who finished second.



Boys

For the third year in a row, Mesilla Valley Christian won the Class A-3A boys state title. The SonBlazers claimed top honors at the 2024 NB3 Foundation State Golf Championships presented by Realty One of New Mexico with a two-day total of 663, 20 strokes ahead of second place Socorro. Individually, Mason Hicks of New Mexico Military Institute posted the top round of day two (78) to earn him medalist honors with a 158 total. Hicks was five shots back heading into the final-round but rallied to end the tournament at New Mexico Tech Golf Course two shots better than second place finisher Riley Morris of Mesilla Valley Christian.
