



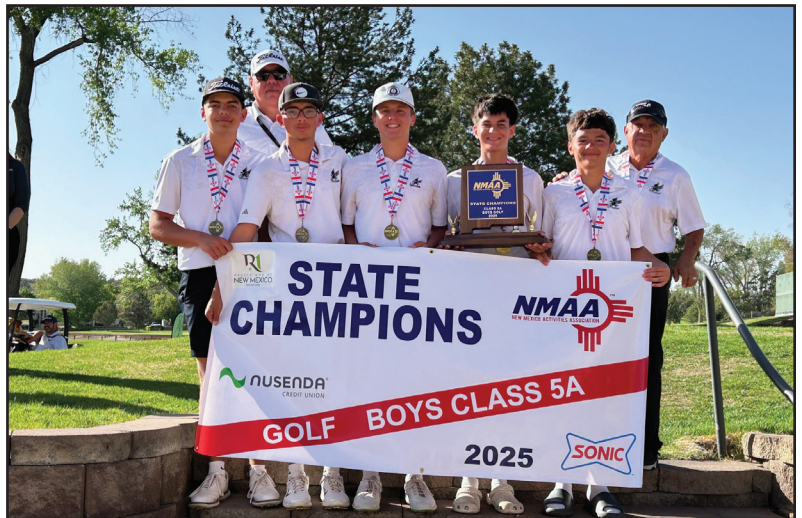
2025 Nusenda Credit Union State Golf Championships presented by Realty One of New Mexico

Volcano Vista Boys & Piedra Vista Girls Both Win 2nd Straight

It took an extra hole for three golfers, but the Volcano Vista Hawks came from behind to win the Class 5A Boys Title at the 2025 Nusenda Credit Union State Golf Championships presented by Realty One of New Mexico. Volcano Vista and La Cueva finished the 36 holes each with a total of 641. The Hawks then went on to beat La Cueva in a one-hole playoff. Each team had three players who teed up on the par-3 18th hole at the San Juan Country Club in Farmington, New Mexico. Volcano Vista's three players posted an aggregate score of 10, one better than La Cueva, as the Hawks won their second straight state championship. Alamogordo was third. Volcano Vista started the day 12 strokes behind La Cueva. Individually, Rio Rancho's Payton Black won medalist honors with a two-round total of 150.

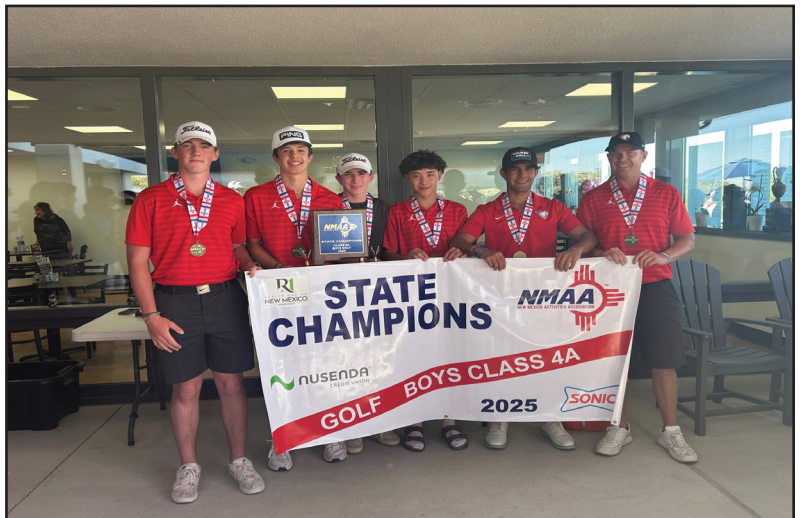
On the girls side, Piedra Vista won their second straight state championship with a score of 670, a dozen shots better than second place La Cueva. Centennial was third with a score of 769. Piedra Vista senior Annie Yost took home top honors with a two-round total of 137. She followed up her opening round 71 with an eye-popping 7-under 66 on the second and final day. Yost recorded 9 birdies in the final round. It's her second-straight state championship. Yost was 12 shots better than Organ Mountain's Eleanor Warden, who finished second.



Class 4A

Albuquerque Academy Makes It A Sweep & Belen Golfer Wins 4th Title

The Class 4A Division of the 2025 Nusenda Credit Union State Golf Championships presented by Realty One of New Mexico belonged to the Albuquerque Academy Chargers and Belen senior Rylee Salome. The Chargers won both the boys and girls team titles as Salome won her 4th individual state championship. The senior finished at even par 144 after two rounds at Pinon Hills Golf Course in Farmington, New Mexico. Salome won the event by five shots. Salome is one of just three golfers to ever win four individual state titles.



The Albuquerque Academy girls finished first with a two-day total of 673. The Chargers were 37 shots ahead of second-place Kirtland Central with 710. Lovington was third with a score of 712. It's the 5th straight state title for the Academy girls.

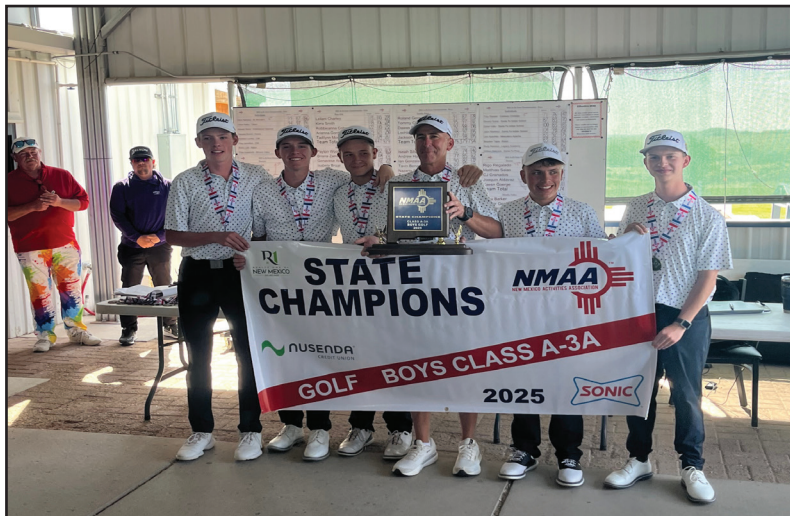
The Albuquerque Academy boys won their second straight state championship with a two round total of 623. The Chargers were 11 shots better than second place Artesia with 634. Lovington was third with 641. Deming senior Riley Apodaca took home medalist honors with a score of 145, beating Lovington's Ramon Orosco by two shots.



Class A-3A

Socorro Girls Dominate and Mesilla Valley Boys Win 4th Straight

The Socorro High School girls golf program continues to separate themselves from the field. Socorro won the Class A-3A Girls Title at the 2025 Nusenda Credit Union State Golf Championships presented by Realty One of New Mexico with a score of 690. Their two-round total at the Riverview Golf Course in the Four Corners was an astounding 116 shots ahead of second place Gateway Christian. It's the 22nd state title overall for Socorro. Individually, Socorro freshman Abbegail Munigan beat her teammate Natasha Apodaca to win medalist honors in a three-hole playoff.



On the boys side, Mesilla Valley Christian won their fourth straight state championship with a total of 634, 21 shots ahead of second place Socorro. New Mexico Military Institute senior Mason Hicks was the individual champion with a score of 144, two-shots better than Isaiah Silva of Socorro.
