



2025 State Softball Championships

Centennial Caps Off Perfect Season

The Centennial Hawks (30-0) dominated the La Cueva Bears (27-5) in the 5A title game at the 2025 NMAA Softball State Championships, capping off a perfect 30-0 season, with a 10-1 win in the championship game.

The Hawks opened up the scoring in the bottom of the first with a two-run homerun to take an early lead. La Cueva cut the lead to 2-1 in the top of the third, but Centennial answered with an additional run at the bottom of the inning, making it 3-1.

Centennial pitching shutdown the La Cueva bats over the next four innings of play, as the Hawks added two more runs in the fifth and five runs in the sixth, taking a 10-1 lead. The Hawks ended the game in the top of the seventh with a four-batter inning, capping off a perfect 30-0 season with their second blue trophy in a row.



Silver Back on Top of 4A Softball

The Silver Fighting Colts (27-4) captured their second state title in three years with a 7-0 win over the Lovington Wildcats (23-10) at the 2025 NMAA State Softball Championships. The Fighting Colts outscored their opponents, 44-4.

The 4A Championship game was a pitching duel over the first four innings of the game as neither team was able to push a run across home plate.

Then in the bottom of the fifth and sixth innings the Silver bats came alive, scoring seven runs between the two innings on eight hits, as the Fighting Colts hoisted the blue trophy.



Cobre Hoists 3A Softball Blue Trophy

The Cobre Indians (23-7) defeated the Dexter Demons (26-4), 5-4, earning their 12th overall state championship at the 2025 NMAA Softball State Championships.

The Class 3A softball championship was an instant classic. The first two innings of play were a true pitcher's duel, as the two teams combined to allow just one hit. Dexter finally got on the board in the bottom of third to take a 1-0 lead. The Demons then added two more in the bottom of the fifth and control of the game.

However, Cobre did not go down without a fight, scoring five runs in the top of the seventh to take a 5-3 advantage. The Demons scored one in the bottom of the inning to make it 5-4 but couldn't manage to push anymore runs across the plate, as Cobre captured the 3A state title.



Loving Gets Number 21

The Loving Falcons (25-7) dominated the Hozho Academy Wolves (25-7), 15-0 in the A/2A finals of the 2025 NMAA State Softball Championships. The Falcons outscored their opponents 69-3 in the state tournament. It's the 21st state softball title for Loving the fourth straight.

Going into the championship round, Loving needed to beat Hozho Academy twice to win the A/2A title. The Falcons forced an IF Game with a 12-0 win over the Wolves.



In game two, the Falcon bats continued to stay hot, scoring 15 runs and shutting out Hozho Academy with a 15-0 and the 21st blue trophy in school history.
