2025 Rudy's Real Texas Bar-B-Q State Volleyball Championships

Class 5A Final

Las Cruces 3, La Cueva 1

(25-9, 25-15, 24-26, 25-22)

Las Cruces powered its way to the 2025 Class 5A state title, defeating La Cueva 3–1 in a championship match that opened with dominance, turned tense in the middle, and closed with a display of grit and composure. The Bulldawgs (27-0) came out on fire, overwhelming La Cueva (24-3) in the first set with a 25–9 statement win fueled by aggressive serving and a fast-paced offense. Las Cruces continued its momentum in the second set, controlling the net and



keeping the Bears off balance to take a 25–15 lead and move within one set of the championship. La Cueva showed its resilience in the third and the Bears edged out a 26–24 win to extend the match. But Las Cruces regrouped quickly. In the fourth set, the Bulldogs reasserted themselves with steady serve-receive and timely kills. Holding off a late La Cueva push, Las Cruces closed out the match 25–22 to secure their third straight state championship. Las Cruces capped off a second straight undefeated season and will carry a 57-match win streak into 2026.

2025 Rudy's Real Texas Bar-B-Q State Volleyball Championships Class 4A Final

St. Pius X 3, Albuquerque Academy 0 (27–25, 25–23, 25–18)

St. Pius X claimed the 2025 Class 4A state title for the third year in a row with a straight-set sweep of rival Albuquerque Academy (21-8). The Sartans (24-3) set the tone in a tense opening set, outlasting the Chargers 27–25 in a back-and-forth battle marked by long rallies and clutch



defensive plays. St. Pius carried that confidence into the second set, edging Academy 25–23 as both teams traded momentum, but the Sartans found key points late to take a 2–0 lead over the Chargers. With the championship within reach, St. Pius X elevated its play in the third set. Strong serving and consistent net play pushed the momentum firmly in the Sartans' favor, leading to a 25–18 clincher to seal the sweep. The victory capped another successful tournament run, earning St. Pius X the 2025 Class 4A state championship crown.

2025 Rudy's Real Texas Bar-B-Q State Volleyball Championships Class 3A Final

Cobre 3, St. Michael's 1

(25-22, 29-31, 25-22, 28-26)

In one of the most dramatic finals of the tournament, Cobre outlasted St. Michael's 3–1 to capture the 2025 Class 3A state championship, with all four sets decided by razor-thin margins. Cobre (24-3) struck first with a 25–22 win in the opening set agains the three-time defending state champs. St. Michael's (24-3) answered in



a marathon second set, surviving multiple set points before pulling out a thrilling 31–29 victory to even the match. The intensity only grew from there. Cobre regained control in the third set, again edging St. Michael's 25–22 thanks to timely hitting and strong back-row play. The fourth set delivered another heart-pounding finish as both teams traded leads deep into extra points.

Ultimately, Cobre closed the door with a 28–26 win to seal the championship. With the victory, Cobre claimed their first Class 3A state title.

2025 Rudy's Real Texas Bar-B-Q State Volleyball Championships Class 2A Final

Legacy Academy 3, Texico 0

(25–19, 25–18, 27–25)

Legacy Academy completed a dominant postseason run with a straight-set sweep of two-tme defending state champ Texico to capture the 2025 Class 2A state cham-



pionship. The Silverbacks (23-2) set the tone early, taking the opening set 25–19 behind sharp serving and a balanced offensive attack. Legacy maintained that momentum in the second set, controlling the pace and keeping Texico (18-9) on its heels to secure a 25–18 advantage and a 2–0 match lead. Texico made its strongest push in the third set, battling point for point in a tightly contested frame. But Legacy Academy rose to the moment, fending off late Texico surges and closing out the match 27–25 to clinch the sweep. With the win, Legacy Academy earned their first Class 2A state title.

2025 Rudy's Real Texas Bar-B-Q State Volleyball Championships Class 1A Final Quemado 3, Melrose 0

(25-14, 25-20, 25-21)

Quemado claimed the 2025 Class 1A state championship with a convincing straight-set victory over Melrose. The Eagles came out strong in the opening set, using aggressive serving and quick offensive runs to build an early lead and pull away for a 25–14 win. In the second set, Melrose settled in and challenged Quemado with longer rallies and improved defense, but the Eagles maintained their composure late to secure a 25–20 advantage and move within a set of the title. Melrose made its biggest push in the third set, trading



points deep into the frame. But every time the Buffaloes threatened, Quemado responded with a key swing or defensive stop. The Eagles closed the match with a steady 25–21 finish to complete the sweep. With the victory, Quemado captured the Class 1A state championship for the second straight season.
