



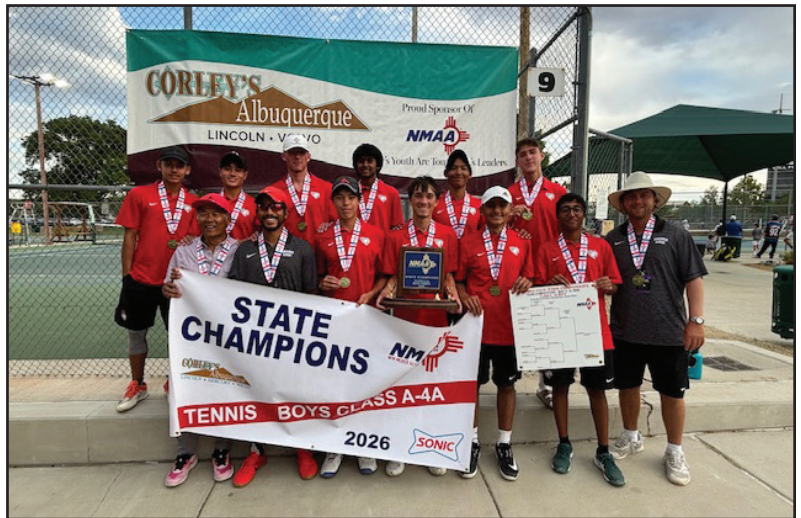
# 2026 NMAA State Tennis Championships presented by Corley's Albuquerque Lincoln Volvo

## Boys A-4A

The Albuquerque Academy boys dominated the tennis world once again. 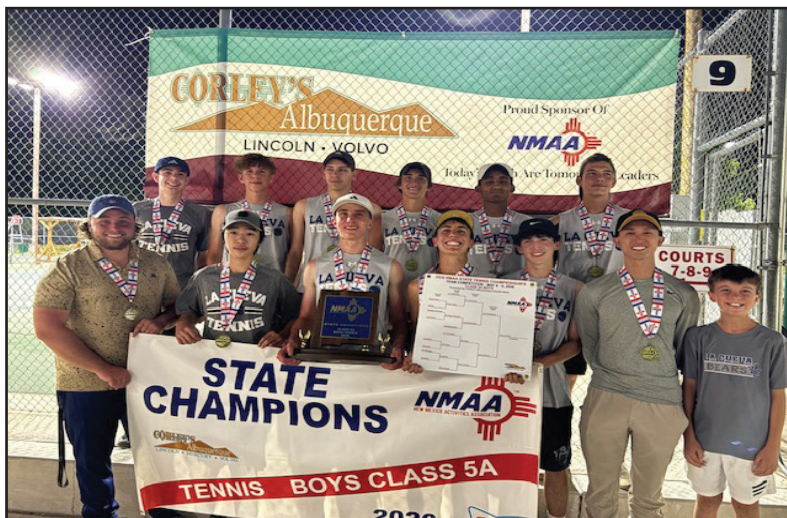


## Boys 5A

The top seeded Lady Scorpions beat Santa Fe in the final by a score of 5-1.
