



NMAA BYLAW CHANGES FOR 2020-2021

The following action was taken during the 2019-2020 school year

September 2019

- Amended eligibility bylaws for foreign exchange direct placement students.
- Amended bylaws pertaining to the sanctioning/addition of new activities.
- Approved an additional sanction for undue influence violations by a coach.
- Amended the state qualifying formula for boys' golf.

December 2019

- Approved an increase in baseball umpires' fees starting with the 2021 season.
- Approved an increase in volleyball match limitations and the elimination of the district tournament.
- Amended state championship qualifiers in 2A & 3A Baseball, A-2A & 3A Softball, A-3A Soccer, 6-man, 8-Man & 2A Football.
- Approved Classification & Alignment for the 2020-2022 block.

February 2020

- Amended individual game limitations in the sport of football.
- Amended pitching restriction regulations in the sport of baseball.
- Amended heat illness prevention protocol bylaws.
- Approved a change to the number of overtime periods for the state soccer finals.
- Approved requiring 3-person officiating crews for all varsity basketball games.
- Amended the cell phone policy for golf to incorporate the use of iWanamaker.
- Amended scholastic eligibility guidelines listed within Section X of the Handbook.
- Amended eligibility guidelines pertaining to foreign exchange and foreign students.
- Approved Classification & Alignment for Swimming & Diving & A-3A Girls Soccer.

May 2020

- Amended summer activity restrictions for Summer 2020 only.
