- 2. Host school is responsible for all expenses. The host site will pay all workers. Pay personnel as per "State Basketball Event Personnel Payment Guidelines." Complete the NMAA "Event Personnel Form" and submit within 10 business days. The NMAA will reimburse schools for all payments made to event workers and/or approved miscellaneous expenses. Please note that any expenses not approved in advance will not be reimbursed after the fact. NMAA issued state basketball passes, according to lists submitted by the schools in advance, **must** be presented at the admission gate. Ticket takers must check one form of picture ID and match it against the name on the pass. Tournament Passes are valid for 1st round of basketball games. **NMOA officials** must present one form of identification (driver's license) and their NMOA membership card for entrance to the event. **NMOA officials will only be permitted complimentary admission to the sport they officiate. For example, basketball officials can receive complimentary admission to state basketball**
