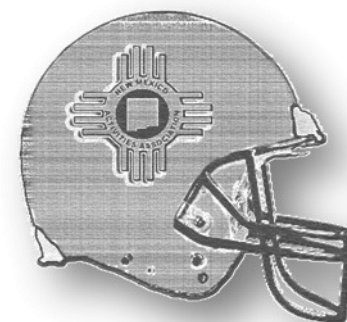
NMAA Scholarships are awarded to students from NMAA member schools who, through the application/nomination process, have been chosen for each individual award because they exemplify the dedication, scholastic achievement and sportsmanship ideals promoted by the Association.

A minimum of 17 scholarships are awarded annually. Last year thirteen scholarships were in the amount of \$1,000 and the remaining four scholarships were in the amount of \$2,500.

\$11,000 of this scholarship funding is provided by Farmers Insurance Group while \$2,000 is provided by UCA/UDA. The remaining scholarship monies come from funds raised by the NMAA Foundation.

VOLUME I—THE FIRST 100 YEARS (1892-1991)

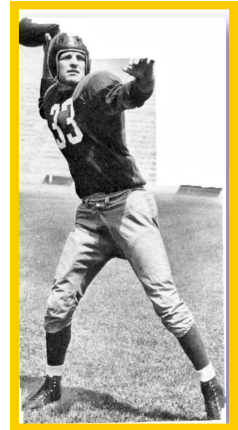
