NEW MEXICO JROTC STATE CHAMPIONSHIP 3P CMP CUP OFFICIAL MATCH PROGRAM

THE CIVILIAN MARKSMANSHIP PROGRAM HAS DESIGNATED THIS MATCH AS THE NEW MEXICO JROTC STATE CHAMPIONSHIP. <u>SHOOTERS WILL HAVE</u> <u>AN OPPORTUNITY TO EARN EIC POINTS AND SET NATIONAL RECORDS!</u>

LOCATION: WE WILL FIRE THIS MATCH AT THE WEST MESA HIGH SCHOOL OLD MAIN GYM IN ALBUQUERQUE, NEW MEXICO.

DATES: Friday, and Saturday (Out of Town Schools) 31 March – 1 April, 2023.

SPONSORING ORGANIZATION: THE NEW MEXICO NATIONAL GUARD SPONSORS THIS MATCH WITH THE ASSISTANCE AND SUPPORT OF THE ELDORADO AND WEST MESA JROTC UNITS.

EVENT: This match is the New Mexico State JROTC Championship. Individual and team competition will be fired in accordance with match rules. The designated match official will be the decision-maker on any rules, equipment, or other rulings. Units may enter Two Marksmanship Teams (4 cadets per team; 1 Sporter and 1 Precision or 2 Sporter Teams or two Precision teams). Individual shooters are encouraged and will compete in either the Sporter or Precision category. Sporter and Precision scores may be mixed for team awards but <u>only as a Precision team</u>! Precision and Sporter team and individual state champions will be determined. Team members <u>are not</u> required to fire at the same time as a team. When scheduling your athletes, coaches be sure to schedule shooters on appropriate relays and to specify team assignments before their first competition shot is fired.

COURSE OF FIRE: THREE-POSITION COMPETITION - In the following sequence: 20 Shots PRONE, 20 Shots STANDING and 20 Shots KNEELING. **The Mega Links electronic scoring system will be used.**

TIME SCHEDULE: Friday – 1100, 1330 and 1600

SATURDAY – 0800, 1030, and 1300 More relays may be added if necessary. If the Saturday relays do not fill up by Friday, 11 March, local teams may move to Saturday. There will be 42 firing points with 6 relays or 252 slots to be filled. BE AT THE RANGE AT LEAST 60 MINUTES BEFORE YOUR FIRING TIME!

ELIGIBILITY: Contestants must be enrolled in a middle or high school and **NEW MEXICO SHOOTERS MUST BE ACADEMICALLY ELIGIBLE ACCORDING TO NMAA STANDARDS**.

RULES: The most recent National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules will govern.

PROTESTS: Protests and appeals will be coordinated IAW the NSTP Air Rifle Rules.

EQUIPMENT: As specified in the National Standard Rules

TIME LIMIT: 20 shots kneeling, 20 shots prone, 20 shots standing (follow CMP rules for position times). There is an 8-minute preparation and sighting stage for prone, and 5-minute preparation and sighting stage for standing and kneeling. There will also be a five-minute changeover period between prone and standing and

between standing and kneeling. (See rules)

AWARDS: THANKS TO THE NEW MEXICO NATIONAL GUARD, THERE WILL BE INDIVIDUAL NEW MEXICO STATE JROTC MEDAL AWARDS IN BOTH SPORTER AND PRECISION

CATEGORIES FOR NEW MEXICO JROTC SHOOTERS. Medals will be awarded for first through third place for each position in each class and first through fifth place "aggregate" in each class. There will be trophies for the top 3 teams in each category. Team awards will be for first, second, and third place teams and will include medals for 1st place team members.
