► ***Monday, August 7, 2017***

First Official Start Date.

Tryouts may not be held prior to this date.

• ***Saturday, August 12, 2017***

First regular season competition may take place.

All coaches, schedules, rosters to include managers for all varsity teams must be posted on MaxPreps.

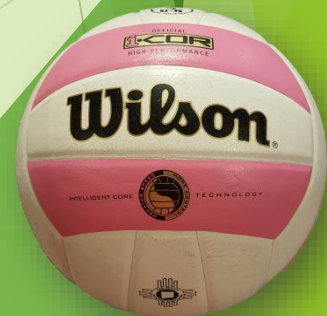
• ***Monday, October 30, 2017***

District Tournament Begins for All Classes.

Seeding/Selection for all Classes.

• ***Thursday-Saturday, November 9-11, 2017*** State Championships.





# 2017 Eligibility Information

- ▶ Each student athlete must have at least 5 practices prior to competing in a match.
- ▶ Must have a current physical and proof of insurance on file with the Athletic Director prior to participating.
- ▶ **8<sup>th</sup> Grade Participation**
  - ▶ Submitted online
  - ▶ Must be completed prior to student athlete practicing/participating with the team.
  - ▶ 8th grade students not already attending the institution they will be participating for must participate at their home attendance zone public high school.



## ● Match Limitations

- Each varsity team or individual
  - limited to 20 total matches prior to the district tournament, including regular season and invitational tournaments.
- Each sub-varsity team or individual
  - limited to 17 total matches including regular season, invitational and district tournament matches.
- Each MS team or individual
  - limited to 14 regular season matches including invitational and district tournament matches.

## ◦ Individual Game Limitations

- ▶ When two schools meet to play two matches involving varsity and sub-varsity teams on a given day or night, each player is limited to a maximum of five games.
- ▶ When two schools meet to play two matches involving any combination of sub-varsity team levels on a given day or night, each player is limited to a maximum of four games.

**NOTE:** Sub-varsity is defined as any level below varsity, including Junior High/Middle School.

## ► Invitational Tournaments

- Host school determines the format (2 out of 3 or 3 out of 5) rally scoring.
- Pool play matches must be 2 games to 25 starting at a score of 4-4, with a cap of 27.
- Must count at least 2 matches towards a team/individuals match limitations.



- **Scrimmages**

- A team is allowed one scrimmage day.
- Must be held prior to a team/individuals first game/match/contest.
- Must be against NMAA/NFHS member schools
- Admission must be free of charge to general public.

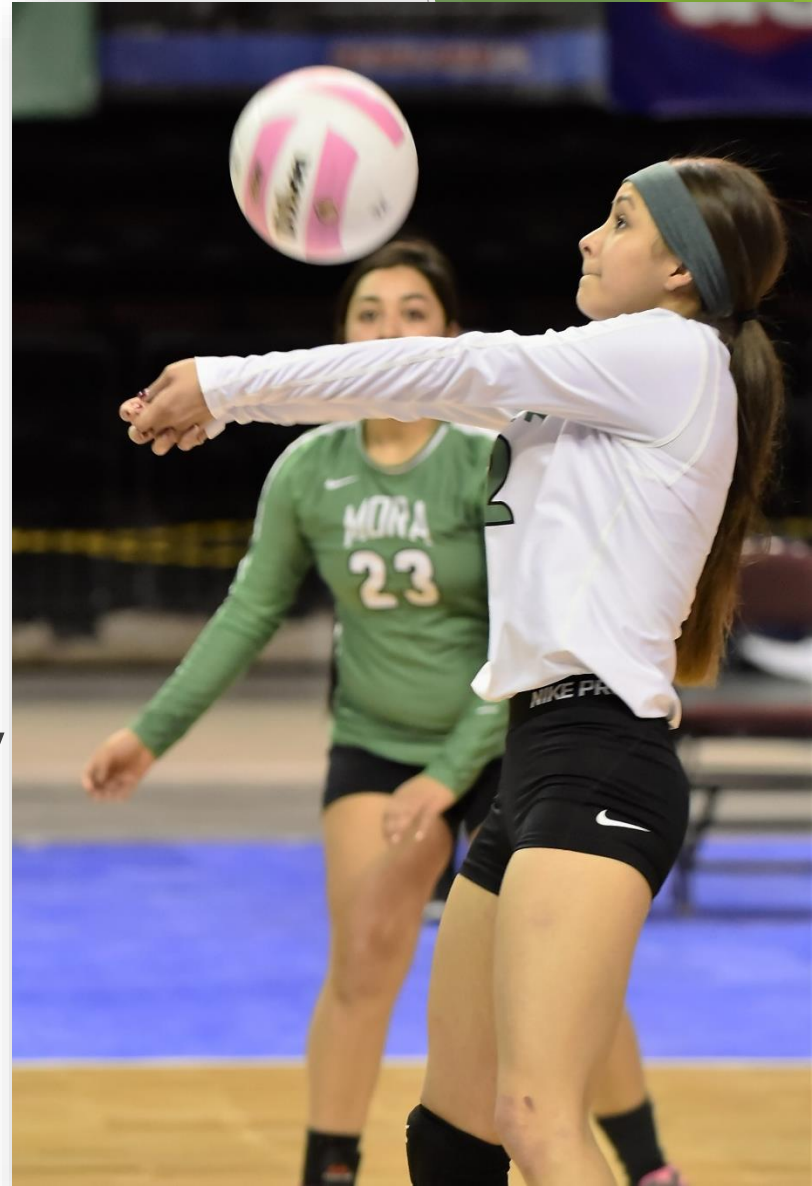
- **Alumni Matches**

- Must be played prior to a team/individuals first game/match/contest.
- Must only include alumni from the school participating
- Does not count towards match limitations.





- **Dual Participation- 6.13.2**
  - Participating on a non-school team in the same sport during the school season is discouraged.
  - If a Student is allowed by the local school district, the student's sub-varsity/varsity event limit may not be exceeded cumulatively. (Sand/Beach volleyball is included)





# Max Preps



**All head coaches must have a MaxPreps account.**

▶ **Add Assistant Coaches and managers as well.**

▶ **Head coach must update team rosters, schedules and scores throughout the season.**

# Libero Uniforms



- ▶ **Libero Jersey-** either the libero and/or her teammates must wear a solid, contrasting colored jersey.
- ▶ **Light vs. dark**



# Coaching Licensure

- **ALL head coaches, assistant coaches and volunteer coaches have a current New Mexico High School coaching license.**
  - **Fundamentals of Coaching**
  - **Renewing/First time coach-take First Aid Course- [nfhslearn.com](http://nfhslearn.com)**
- ▶ **NFHS Concussion Course- must be completed annually by coaches and players.**
- ▶ **Concussion fact sheets-completed by athletes and parents.**



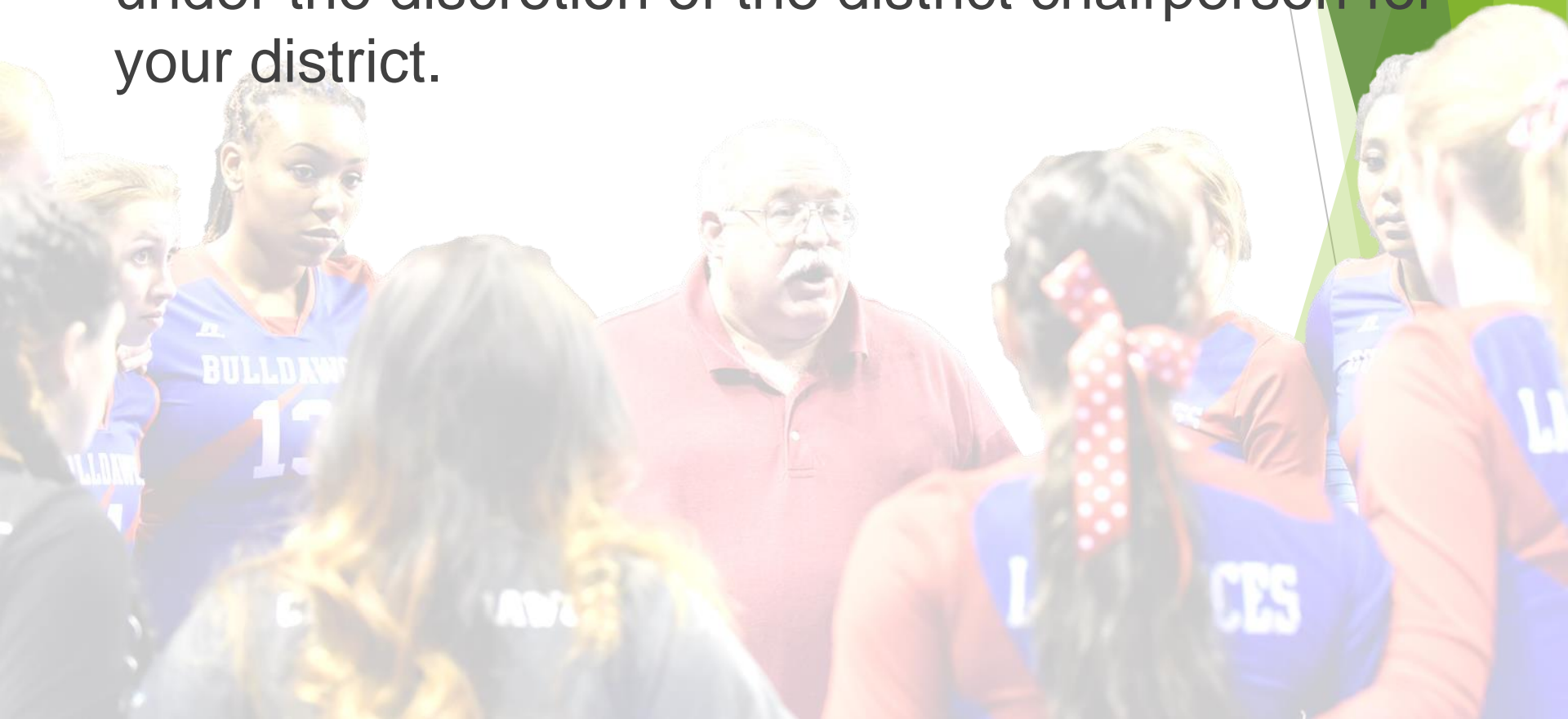


# Concussion Law

- ▶ SB 38- All student athletes are now required to take the NFHS Concussion Course online at [nfhslearn.com](http://nfhslearn.com) prior to participating.
- ▶ SB 137- *If a student athlete exhibits any signs/symptoms of a brain injury, he/she is not to participate in school athletic activity any sooner than 240 hours from the hour in which the athlete received a brain injury.*
  - ▶ *Physician release to return to play.*

# District Tournaments

- ▶ Each team is limited to fourteen (14) uniformed members.
- ▶ District Tournament sites, seeding, bracket etc. are under the discretion of the district chairperson for your district.



# Out of Season Coaching

- ▶ A Coaching Staff is allowed 7.5 hours of total contact time per week during the off-season. Each coach does not get 7.5 hours with athletes. Its all inclusive (volunteer, varsity, sub-varsity coaches etc).
- ▶ 8th graders are eligible to participate in out-of-season practices. NO 7<sup>th</sup> graders.
- ▶ Coaching should not take place on holidays, weekends, snow days or in-service days.
- ▶ Sports specific and sports specific conditioning classes are included within the 7.5 hours/week.
- ▶ A high school coach may coach a club team during the off season seeing that the club team is not made up of any current or potential feeder school athletes.



# Criteria Used for Seeding and Selection

- 1. Finish in Regular Season district play**
- 2. Head to Head**
- 3. Wins against District Champions regardless of class**
- 4. Overall Record**
- 5. MaxPreps Freeman Rankings**
- 6. Member School Coaches Input**

**\*\*NOTE:** In the event of a tie among criteria points:

- 1. Head to Head**
- 2. Max Preps Freeman Rankings**

**\*Coaches Input forms are due by 8:00 a.m. on Sunday, November 5, 2017.**



# 2017 State Championships

- **November 9-11, 2017**
- **Santa Ana Star Center, Rio Rancho High School and Cleveland High School.**
- **Each team is allowed 14 uniformed players for the state championships.**
- **A 20 person maximum per team for the state championships. (coaches, players, scorekeepers, athletic trainers, managers, etc.)**
- **Pink Jerseys may only be worn during pool play.**
- **State Schedule to be posted at the end of August**

# Cancer Awareness Match

- ▶ Any home match during month of October
- ▶ Wear pink jerseys- optional, must have numbers at least on back.
- ▶ Side-Out Foundation





# Verification of Equipment and Sportsmanship Regulations

- ▶ Please understand the following; it is your responsibility to ensure that your sub-varsity coaches (JV, C-Team, Freshmen, etc) are aware of the information as well.

**I acknowledge that .....all players:**

1. have been informed what equipment is mandatory and what constitutes illegal equipment.
2. have been provided the equipment mandated by rule.
3. have been instructed to wear and how to wear mandatory equipment during a game.
4. have been instructed to notify the coaching staff when equipment becomes illegal through play during the game.
5. have been made aware of and will practice the safety as well as the sportsmanship regulations in concert with NFHS and NMAA rules.
