

## **2008-2009 Eligibility Synopsis** **(02/01/2009-02/28/2009)**

### **Bylaw 6.5.2**

Belen High School- junior transfer student petitioning the transfer rule. The student previously attended another member school. The NMAA ruled ineligible for varsity athletic participation for 90 school days from the date of enrollment.

Eldorado High School- junior transfers student petitioning the transfer rule. The student previously attended another member school. The NMAA ruled ineligible for varsity athletic participation.

Goddard High School- senior transfer student petitioning the transfer rule. The student previously attended another member school. The NMAA ruled ineligible for varsity athletic participation.

Los Alamos High School- junior transfer student petitioning the transfer rule. The student previously attended a school out of state however is living with relatives. The NMAA ruled ineligible for varsity athletic participation.

Los Alamos High School- junior transfer student petitioning the transfer rule. The student previously attended a school out of state however is living with relatives. The NMAA ruled ineligible for varsity athletic participation.

Los Alamos High School- sophomore transfer student since the beginning of the year petitioning the transfer rule. The student previously attended another member school. The NMAA ruled ineligible for varsity athletic participation 90 days from the date of enrollment at Los Alamos High school.

Loving High School- junior transfer student since the beginning of the year petitioning the transfer rule. The student previously attended another member school. The NMAA ruled ineligible for varsity athletic participation 90 days from the date of enrollment at Loving High school.

Tohatchi High School- junior transfer student since the beginning of the year petitioning the transfer rule. The student previously attended another member school. The NMAA ruled ineligible for varsity athletic participation 90 days from the date of enrollment at Tohatchi High school.

Tucumcari High School- freshman transfer student since the beginning of the year petitioning the transfer rule. The student previously attended another member school. The NMAA ruled ineligible for varsity athletic participation 90 days from the date of enrollment at Tucumcari High school.

Valley High School- senior transfer student since the beginning of the year petitioning the transfer rule. The student previously attended another member school. The NMAA ruled ineligible for varsity athletic participation 90 days from the date of enrollment at Valley High school.

Valley High School- two junior transfer students since the beginning of the year petitioning the transfer rule. The students previously attended another member school. The NMAA ruled ineligible for varsity athletic participation 90 days from the date of enrollment at Valley High school.

Thoreau High School- senior transfer student petitioning the transfer rule. The student previously attended another member school. The student previously falsified information and the NMAA ruled ineligible for 180 school days. The petition was sent to the appeals committee where it was upheld. However, pursuant to Rule 2.2.2, and the circumstances surrounding, the NMAA granted eligibility after the student sat out the 90 day ineligibility period.

### **Bylaw 6.6.2**

Del Norte High School- junior transfer student from another member school requesting varsity eligibility. The student did not participate in athletics while in attendance there. The NMAA granted the request for immediate varsity eligibility.

Deming High School- senior transfer student from another member school requesting varsity eligibility. The student did not participate in athletics while in attendance there. The NMAA granted the request for immediate varsity eligibility. As a senior, the student must practice for 5 days prior to participating in a competition.

Espanola Valley High School- senior transfer student from an out of state school requesting varsity eligibility. The student did not participate in athletics while in attendance there. The NMAA granted the request for immediate varsity eligibility. As a senior, the student must practice for 5 days prior to participating in a competition.

Peñasco High School- two freshman transfer student from another member school requesting varsity eligibility. The student did not participate in athletics while at their previous school. The NMAA granted the request for immediate varsity eligibility.

Piedra Vista High School- senior transfer student from another member school requesting varsity eligibility. The student did not participate in athletics while at their previous school. The NMAA granted the request for immediate varsity eligibility. As a senior, the student must practice with the team for 5 days prior to participating in a competition.

### **Bylaw 6.5.3**

Goddard High School- a senior transfer student requesting varsity eligibility who previously attended another member school. The student and family relocated within the Goddard High attendance zone. The NMAA granted the request for immediate varsity eligibility. As a senior, the student must practice for 5 days with the team prior to participating in a competition.

Hobbs High School- a senior transfer student requesting varsity eligibility who previously attended a school out of state. The student and family relocated within the Hobbs High attendance zone. The NMAA granted the request for immediate varsity eligibility. As a senior, the student must practice for 5 days with the team prior to participating in a competition.

Los Alamos High School- a sophomore transfer student requesting varsity eligibility who previously attended a school out of state. The student and family relocated within the Los Alamos High attendance zone. The NMAA granted the request for immediate varsity eligibility.

Piedra Vista High School- a senior transfer student requesting varsity eligibility who previously attended a school out of state. The student and family relocated within the Piedra Vista High attendance zone. The NMAA granted the request for immediate varsity eligibility. As a senior, the student must practice with the team for 5 days prior to competing in a competition.

Santa Teresa High School- a senior transfer student requesting varsity eligibility who previously attended a school out of state. The student and family relocated within the Santa Teresa High attendance zone. The NMAA granted the request for immediate varsity eligibility. As a senior, the student must practice with the team for 5 days prior to competing in a competition.

### **Bylaw 6.9.2**

Albuquerque Academy- fifth year senior petitioning for an additional year of athletic eligibility. Based on the circumstances surrounding, the NMAA granted an extra year of eligibility.

**Bylaw 6.4.3**

Taos High School- freshman student attending Taos High School. Based on the documentation providing, the student's place of residence was court ordered therefore NMAA granted immediate varsity eligibility.

Rio Rancho High School- junior transfer student to Rio Rancho High School requesting eligibility. The student is living with relatives whom have physical custody and is due to a court order. The NMAA granted immediate eligibility.

**Bylaw 10.5**

Pecos High School- home school student residing the Pecos attendance area. The NMAA granted the student immediate eligibility for one sport at Pecos High School for the 08-09 school year.

**Bylaw 6.5.6**

Del Norte High School- two foreign exchange students currently attending Del Norte High School and are part of a formal program from the C.S.I.E.T. approved list meeting all age and academic requirements. The NMAA granted immediate athletic eligibility for the remainder of the year at Del Norte High School.

Los Alamos High School- foreign exchange student currently attending Los Alamos High School and is part of a formal program from the C.S.I.E.T. approved list meeting all age and academic requirements. The NMAA granted immediate athletic eligibility for the remainder of the year at Los Alamos High School.

Piedra Vista High School- foreign exchange student currently attending Piedra Vista High School and is part of a formal program from the C.S.I.E.T. approved list meeting all age and academic requirements. The NMAA granted immediate athletic eligibility for the remainder of the year at Del Norte High School.
