

2009-2010 Eligibility Synopsis **(4/01/2009-06/30/2009)**

Bylaw 6.5.2

Cibola High School- junior transfer student to Cibola High School petitioning the transfer rule. The student did not leave the previous school in good standing. The NMAA ruled ineligible for 180 school days from the date of enrollment there.

Oñate High School- senior transfer student to Oñate High School petitioning the transfer rule. The student transferred from another member school. The NMAA ruled ineligible for 90 school days from the date of enrollment. As a senior, the student is ineligible for sub-varsity athletic participation and cannot practice with the team during the period of ineligibility.

Eldorado High School- incoming freshman transfer student who played as an eighth grader at another member school. The NMAA ruled ineligible for 90 school days from the date of enrollment there.

Robertson High School- two sophomore transfer students petitioning the transfer rule. The students previously attended other member schools, participating in only the sport of basketball at the previous schools. The NMAA ruled ineligible for varsity athletic participation for 90 school days from the date of enrollment. However, pursuant to Rule 6.6.2, the students are eligible immediately for all fall sports at Robertson High School.

Bylaw 6.6.2

Piedra Vista High School- senior transfer student from a out of state school requesting for varsity eligibility. The student did not participate in athletics while in attendance there. The NMAA granted the request for immediate eligibility.
