

NMAA On-Line Rule Clinics

Rule Clinics will be hosted on-line for all sports during the 2009-2010 school year. The on-line clinics are required for all **head coaches** and are easy to access and complete. The most important part of the on-line clinic is that all head coaches must have a valid MVP account and an approved role prior to receiving credit.

Each sport's page on the NMAA website contains a district rule clinic area which will become active during a specified time period throughout the year.

- Fall (August 1-31)
- Winter (November 1-30)
- Spring (February 1-28)

Once the head coach completes the clinic, he/she will be given the opportunity to "Get Credit For Attending." Upon completion of this part of the clinic, their name and school will appear on the "Credit For Attending" page of the website.

Failure to complete the on-line clinic will result in a \$100.00 fine.
