HALL OF FAME Eligibility, Nominating Procedures and Information

The NMAA Hall of Fame includes individuals who have made significant contributions to interscholastic education in this state over an extended period of time. The Hall of Fame/Awards Committee invites nominations for potential inductees.

Eligibility – Documentation of the following:

- A. Minimum of 25 years of school service, at least 20 of which must have been in New Mexico.
- B. Involvement in inter-school activities/athletics as a coach, sponsor, administrator, etc.
- C. Support of the NMAA philosophy and objectives.
- D. Involvement in formulating regulations and procedures for interscholastic education programs.

Nomination Process

- A. Obtain and use the nomination form from the NMAA office or through the NMAA website at www.nmact.org. Necessary information includes the nominee's name, address, family information, education background, teaching/coaching/advising experience, NMAA committee experience, professional organizations/activities honors and community activities; a photo is requested with the nomination application.
- B. Three letters of recommendation are required. An up to date resume is requested.
- C. Nomination forms and supplemental information may be submitted to the NMAA at any time, but must be received by **December 1st** for consideration in the current year. The forms must be complete.

Selection

- A. The NMAA President and Executive Director appoint a Hall of Fame Selection Committee which meets annually in the late fall to screen nominees.
- B. The committee selects a maximum of four individuals for induction each year.
- C. Nominees not selected for induction remain in consideration for two additional years and may be re-submitted after that time.

Award

- A. Inductions are made at the Boys State Basketball Tournament in March; inductees receive a commemorative plaque and Hall of Fame ring.
- B. Inductees' photos and a synopsis of accomplishments are published in that tournament's program.
- C. Inductees have a photograph (8" x 10"), and a resume of accomplishments placed in the Hall of Fame, located in the NMAA Hall of Pride and Honor.
- D. Inductees receive lifetime passes to NMAA-sponsored events (tournaments/meets).

Note: The NM High School Coaches Association and the NM Officials Association sponsor their respective halls of fame, which are displayed in the NMAA Hall of Pride and Honor. NMAA Hall of Fame candidates must be individuals who have contributed to the life of the NMAA over an extended period of time.
