Super Saturday To Showcase 8 Man Football

ALBUQUERQUE, NM- The New Mexico Activities Association would like to announce that three 8 Man football games will be played at Menaul High School on Saturday, Sept. 29 in what is being called “**Super Saturday.**”

Menaul High School will host three 8 Man football games to highlight the second year of 8 Man football in New Mexico.

The first game of the day will feature Pine Hill vs. Floyd at 10:30 AM. The second game is scheduled to kickoff at 1:30 PM and will match up Melrose vs. Menaul. Super Saturday will conclude with the final game against Springer and Reserve at 4:30 PM.

With the purchase of a \$5.00 ticket, fans will have the opportunity to watch all three games throughout the day.

Mario Martinez, NMAA Associate Director, who oversees the sport of football for the NMAA said “The first year of Eight Man football proved to be a great success. Spectators and fans seem to like the resemblance of 8 Man to that of the 11 Man game. The NMAA hopes that fans will take the opportunity to attend Super Saturday.”

The NMAA Board of Directors decided to implement an 8 Man football league beginning with the 2006 season. The 8 man football league consists of fourteen district teams, while the current Six Man league has remained with approximately seven teams. Six Man football was implemented in New Mexico in 1987.
