**First Community Bank State Basketball Championship
Ticket Information**

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. - The New Mexico Activities Association would like to provide information regarding the purchase of tickets for the 2007 First Community Bank State Basketball Championships.

The 2007 State Tournament (March 6-10) will feature non-stop basketball action at The Pit, Santa Ana Star Center and Rio Rancho High School. Games at The Pit (March 6-10) and the Santa Ana Star Center (March 6-8) will begin at 8:00 am, with the last game of the evening to tip off at approximately 8:30 pm. Rio Rancho High School will host Class A quarterfinals beginning at 3:15 pm on March 6 and 7.

The NMAA is currently selling an All-Tournament Pass, only good for the State Championships in Albuquerque and Rio Rancho on March 6-10. The All-Tournament pass may only be purchased at the NMAA Office or by phone (505-923-3265), through March 5th at 2:00 pm, while supplies last.

The All-Tournament Pass, which costs \$100.00, allows for re-entry privileges and permits the holder the same chair back seat at The Pit for all 38 games. The All-Tournament Pass also provides a lower level seat at the Santa Ana Star Center and a general admission seat at Rio Rancho High School for no additional cost.

Advanced general admission tickets for The Pit are available at the UNM Ticket Offices, on-line at www.unmtickets.com, by phone at (505) 925-5858 or 1-800-905-3315 and at Tickets.com outlets. Spectators can purchase general admission tickets and remain in The Pit for the entire day. Chair back seats at The Pit will cost \$15.00 a day and general admission tickets will cost \$5 for students/seniors and \$10 for adults.

Tickets for the Santa Ana Star Center (\$5 students/seniors and \$10 adults) and Rio Rancho High School (\$5 students/seniors and \$8 adults) can only be purchased at the event location on game day one hour prior to the first game.

District and Regional basketball tournament tickets will only be sold by the host school for \$5.00 (adults and/or students).
