

## **NMAA Scholarships**

### **Presented by the NMAA Foundation**

*The following NMAA Scholarships are awarded to students from NMAA member schools who, through the application/nomination process, have been chosen for each individual award because they exemplify the dedication, scholastic achievement and sportsmanship ideals promoted by the Association. All scholarships allow for a candidate to apply personally or be nominated for the award. A single selection committee examines each candidate and chooses recipients based on the distribution below.*

**A total of 16 scholarships are awarded as shown below. 14 of these scholarships are in the amount of \$1,000. The remaining two scholarships are in the amount of \$2,500 and are given to the two most deserving students regardless of scholarship category.**

#### **Pursuing Victory With Honor Scholarship - 6 scholarships awarded**

Candidates for monetary scholarship disbursement are graduating seniors who meet the Pursuing Victory With Honor perspective and truly exhibit sportsmanship. (Individuals and groups NOT graduating from High School are still eligible for PVWH recognition, but are not eligible to receive a scholarship.)

#### **Dan and Lucille Wood Athletic Scholarship - 2 scholarships awarded**

Candidates are graduating seniors who will be evaluated on their participation and achievement in athletics as well as academics.

#### **Activities Scholarship - 2 scholarships awarded**

Candidates are graduating seniors who will be evaluated on their participation and achievement in activities as well as academics.

#### **El Richards/Francis Walsh Spirit Scholarship - 2 scholarships awarded**

Candidates are graduating seniors who will be evaluated on their participation and achievement in Cheer and/or Dance/Drill as well as academics.

#### **Extraordinary Participation Scholarship - 2 scholarships awarded**

Candidates are graduating seniors who are active participants in BOTH activities and athletics and will be evaluated on their participation and achievement in such as well as academics.

#### **At Large - 2 scholarships awarded**

The two recipients in this “category” may come from any of the above categories. This allows the selection committee to recognize two more students who are deserving of a scholarship but may not be considered one of the top two in the category they fall into.

***Application/Nomination deadline for ALL scholarships is February 12, 2010. The selection committee will meet on February 24<sup>th</sup>, and recipients will be recognized at the State Basketball Tournament.***
