Re: Pool Play Format

Pool Play will be round robin with four pools of three teams for Classes 3A-5A, and two pools of four for Classes A and AA. For Classes 3A-5A, each match will consist of two games to 25 points, rally scoring, with a cap of 27 points. For Classes A and AA, each match will consist of two games to 21 points, rally scoring, with a cap of 23 points.

Placement in the tournament will then be determined by the following criteria:

1. Win-Loss Record

In the event of a tie:

- i. Head to head games
- ii. Head to head points – The team that scored the most points within the two games is the higher seed.
- iii. Difference in points scored vs. points given up in all pool play games
- iv. Coin Flip

2. Finish in pool play will determine placement in the pre-determined brackets.

3. All teams will have a full warm-up prior to their first pool play game. After the first round, warm-up will consist of 3-3-2.
