

NMAA Online Rules Clinics

Rules Clinics will again be hosted online for all sports during the 2011-2012 school year. The online clinics are required for all **head coaches** and are easy to access and complete. In order to properly receive credit for attending an online clinic, head coaches **MUST have a valid MVP account and an approved role in the MVP system.**

Each sports page on the NMAA website contains a district rules clinic area (see image below) which will become active during a specific time period:

- Fall Sports (August 1-31)
- Winter Sports (November 1-30)
- Spring Sports (February 1-29)

Once a head coach completes the clinic, he/she will be given the opportunity to “Get Credit For Attending”. Upon completion of this portion of the clinic, the name of the head coach and their school will appear on the “Rules Clinic Attendance” page at http://www.nmact.org/rules_clinics/.

Failure to complete the online clinic by the deadline will subject the school to a \$100.00 fine.
