

2010-2011 Eligibility Synopsis **(04/01/2010-04/30/2010)**

Bylaw 6.6.2

Taos High School- senior transfer student to Taos High School. The student did not participate in athletics the previous year. The NMAA ruled eligible immediately for varsity athletic participation.

Bylaw 6.5.2

Gallup High School- freshman transfer student Gallup High School. The student previously attended another member school. The NMAA denied varsity athletic eligibility participation. The student is eligible for sub-varsity participation.

Estancia High School- junior transfer student Estancia High School. The student previously attended another member school. The NMAA denied varsity athletic eligibility participation. The student is eligible for sub-varsity participation.

Piedra Vista High School- sophomore transfer student Piedra Vista High School. The student previously attended another member school. The NMAA denied varsity athletic eligibility participation. The student is eligible for sub-varsity participation.

Bylaw 6.5.3

Taos High School- two junior transfer students to Taos High School. The student and family relocated and established a permanent residence within the Taos High attendance area. The NMAA rules immediate varsity eligibility at Taos High School in all sports

Oñate High School- sophomore transfer student to Oñate High School. The student and family relocated and established a permanent residence within the Oñate High attendance area. The NMAA rules immediate varsity eligibility at Oñate High School in all sports
