

2010-2011 Eligibility Synopsis **(05/01/2010-05/31/2010)**

Bylaw 6.6.2

Moriarty High School- sophomore transfer student to Moriarty High School. The student previously attended another member school the previous year. The student participated in the sport of basketball only while in attendance there. The student was granted varsity eligibility in all other sports at Moriarty. The student is eligible for sub-varsity only in the sport of basketball until the 90-school day varsity ineligibility period has been served.

Bylaw 6.5.2

Clovis High School- junior transfer student to Clovis High School. The student previously attended another member school. The NMAA denied varsity athletic eligibility participation. The student is eligible for sub-varsity participation.

Gallup High School- freshman transfer student Gallup High School. The student previously attended another member school. The NMAA denied varsity athletic eligibility participation. The student is eligible for sub-varsity participation.

Bylaw 6.14

Ruidoso High School- senior student attending Ruidoso High School. The student will turn 19 prior to the September 1st date. The student therefore is ineligible for sports at all levels for the 2010-2011 school year at Ruidoso High School.

Bylaw 6.5.3

Clovis High School- junior transfer student to Clovis High School. The student and family relocated and established a permanent residence within the Clovis High attendance area. The NMAA rules immediate varsity eligibility at Clovis High School.

Bylaw 6.4.3

Carlsbad High School- junior transfer student to Carlsbad High School. Based on court ordered legal guardianship papers, the NMAA granted immediate varsity athletic participation at Carlsbad High School.
