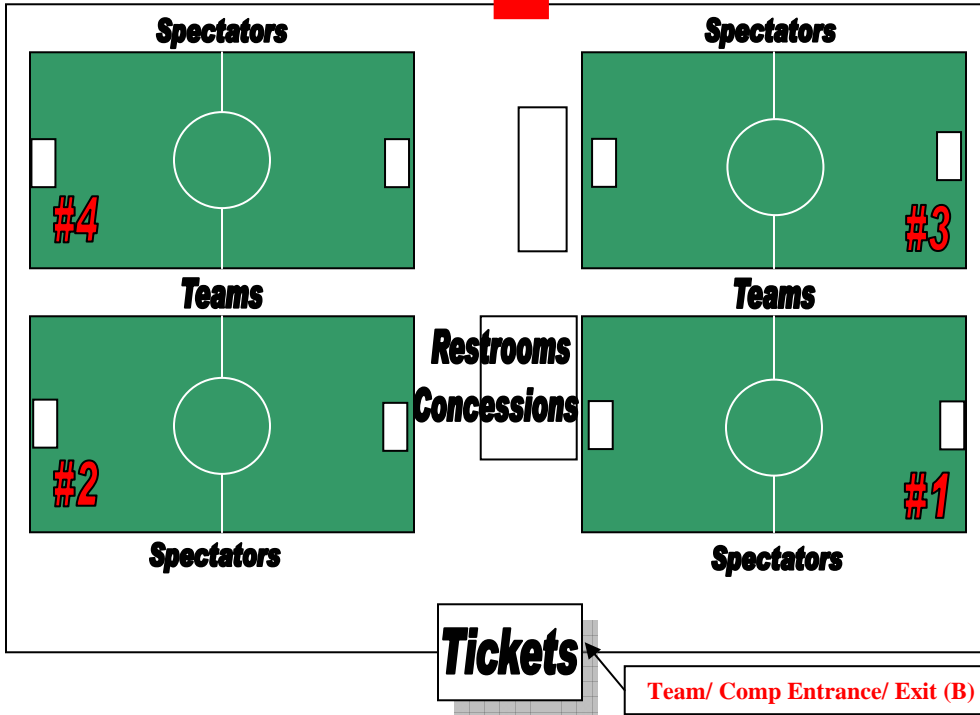

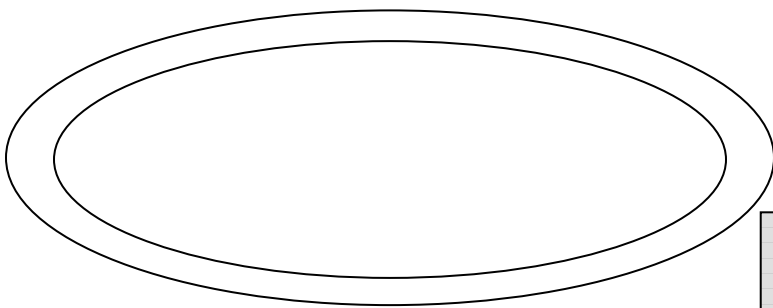

Directions to APS Soccer Complex

From I-25 and Paseo Del Norte (See map below)

Go West on Paseo Del Norte passing Jefferson, the Rio Grande river, Coors Blvd., Eagle Ranch and Golf Course (6 miles). Continue on Paseo Del Norte for approximately 2.5 miles to Universe. Once at Universe turn left or go straight.

If turn left at Universe turn right on Treeline or Woodmount, within a half mile. Take either Treeline or Woodmount to Rainbow; turn left and the APS Soccer Complex will be directly behind Tony Hillerman middle school on the right.

If continue straight on Paseo Del Norte for a half mile turn left at Rainbow (four way stop sign). Take Rainbow approximately one mile. The APS Soccer Complex will be directly behind Tony Hillerman middle school on the right.

From I-40 and Unser (See map below)

Go North on Unser, passing Montano (4.60 miles). Continue on Unser. At approximately 6.5 miles, turn left at stop light (Rainbow). Continue on Rainbow and the APS Soccer Complex will be directly behind Tony Hillerman middle school on the left.

General Information

FORMAT:

The 2011 NMAA State Soccer Championships is a 12 team single elimination tournament. The first round of 12 is scheduled for Oct. 28-29 at home sites of the higher seeded team; with the top four seeds having a bye. The quarterfinals, semifinals and finals will be played in three consecutive days (Nov. 3-5).

PASSES:

All coaches **must** pick up a coaches packet prior to their first game. Packets can be picked up at the NMAA starting on Tuesday, Nov. 1 at 9:00 AM. Packets may also be picked up at the APS Soccer Complex comp gate beginning Thur. Nov. 3 at 7:30 AM.

Athletes and coaches must have been posted on the NMAA website no later than 5:00 PM on Monday, Oct. 24 to be granted a tournament pass. Teams are limited to 22 player passes. Schools will be invoiced \$24.00 for the 2011 State Soccer Championships for any coaches not posted on the NMAA website.

One manager's pass will be included in each team's packet.

Please ensure that your athletes, coaches and managers keep this pass, as this will grant access during the tournament. Additional passes **WILL NOT** be provided.

FIELDS:

The 2011 NMAA State Soccer Championships will be held at the Albuquerque Public Schools soccer complex. The four-field complex is located just west of Volcano Vista High School on Albuquerque's west-side. All four fields at the APS Soccer Complex have lights and are artificial turf; fields are 110 x 68 yards.

Teams will be permitted into the complex an hour and a half prior to the first game of the day. Spectator and fan entrance's will open one hour prior to the first game.

PRACTICE:

No teams shall practice at the APS Soccer Complex prior to the tournament.

BUS PARKING:

In order to provide ample parking for spectators and fans all buses are required to park in the designated bus parking area, located west of the APS Soccer Complex field #3 (*See map on page 3*). Buses will not be permitted to drop teams off or pick teams up at the front entrance of the APS Soccer Complex.

TEAM ENTRANCE:

Teams that ride a bus will enter and exit through the back/ West gate, while players that ride with a parent or drive themselves will enter and exit through the front/ East gate.

ADMINISTRATOR ENTRANCE:

Administrators will have to identify themselves accordingly upon arrival at the complimentary entrance gate. Please ensure that all administrators have some form of identification.

MISCONDUCT:

All misconduct rules and regulations will be enforced during the entire tournament.

7.17.5 Misconduct Progression Rule

A. Regular Season

1. Yellow cards received during regular season or tournament competition must be counted. Once a player has accumulated five yellow cards, they are suspended for the next game. Once the player accumulates three additional yellow cards (totaling eight yellow cards), they are suspended for the next two games and are required to attend a meeting with the school's Athletic Director, head coach and the NMAA Executive Director or his/her designee. Any additional yellow cards received by a player after eight total cards will be subject to more severe penalties by the NMAA Executive Director, including but not limited to suspension from additional contests.
2. Any team whose players and coaches, during the regular season, collectively receive a total of 24 or more yellow cards (including all second yellow/red cards and straight red cards) will be required to attend a meeting with the school's Athletic Director and the NMAA Executive Director or his/her designee.
3. Any school receiving 32 or more yellow cards will be prohibited from participation in post-season. Any yellow/red cards received by the coach will count toward the 32 card total. (Note: The 32 card total is in effect for a two-year block, at which time this amount will be revisited by the NMAA Soccer Sport-Specific Committee and NMAA Commission.)
4. If a player receives a red card or a second yellow card resulting in disqualification, that individual is suspended for the next scheduled game. These are minimum penalties. All yellow and red cards must be reported to the NMAA.
5. Coaches who are ejected must sit out the next contest minimally in post season as well as regular season play.

B. Post Season

Upon the commencement of post-season, all players and coaches receive a “clean slate” for the accumulation of cards. However, any pending sit-out resulting from the accumulation of cards or a direct send-off must be fulfilled in post-season if the requirement for a sit-out has not been satisfied during the regular season. For example, if a player receives his/her fifth yellow card or is sent off during the final regular season game, he/she will be required to sit out the first game of the post-season if the team has qualified for post-season competition or the first game of the next season if the team has not qualified for post-season competition.

1. If a player is ejected for “persisting in misconduct after receiving caution” (a “second yellow card” offense) he/she is charged with one caution in that contest. However, the player ejected is not permitted to participate in the following contest.
2. Any yellow cards received during the regular season DO NOT carry over into the post - season. NOTE: If an athlete receives the 5th, 7th, 9th, etc. yellow card in the last game of the regular season, the athlete will still be required to sit out the first game in post-season play. Athletes who receive a second yellow card in post-season play will be required to sit out the next game. Also, an athlete who receives a red card must sit out the next game minimally, no matter when it is received.
3. Coaches who are ejected must sit out the next contest minimally in post season as well as regular season play.

UNIFORMS:

The higher seeded team is considered the home team and will therefore wear white or the lighter colored jersey. The lower seed shall wear the darker colored jersey.

NFHS Rules 4 Section 1 Article 1 (a) states: jerseys and socks of opposing teams shall be of contrasting colors and in the event of a similarity of color; the home team shall be responsible for making the necessary change. (b) The home team shall wear white or light jerseys and socks, and the visiting team shall wear dark jerseys and socks.

INCLEMENT WEATHER PROCEDURES:

In the event that a state tournament game is postponed or cancelled due to inclement weather, the Tournament Director and NMAA Executive Director will reschedule the contest(s) based on all factors affecting the tournament.

Note: The only spectators permitted to leave and re-enter the facility will be those who purchase a day pass for \$12.

WATER:

Each team bench will have a Gatorade cooler with ice water and cups. If your team would prefer a sports or performance drink.....please ensure that an additional cooler is brought by your team.

ATHLETIC TRAINERS:

Athletic trainers have been scheduled to be on-site throughout the tournament. Should you need an athletic trainer, please notify a field manager immediately.

OFFICIAL BOOK:

The official book will be kept by the home team (higher seed).

OFFICIAL BALL:

The official ball of the 2011 State Soccer Championships (first round included) will be the Wilson Ultimo NCAA Game Ball. The Wilson Ultimo will be provided for play during the quarterfinals, semifinals and finals.



SCOREBOARDS:

A scoreboard will be present at each field during the tournament.

OFFICIAL APPAREL:
