**Re:** Pool Play

---

Pool Play will be round robin with four pools of three teams for Classes A-5A, and two pools of four for Class B. For Classes A-5A, each match will consist of two games to 25 points, rally scoring, with a cap of 27 points. For Class B, each match will consist of two games to 21 points, rally scoring, with a cap of 23 points.

All teams will have a warm-up time of 4-4-2 for their first pool play game. After the first round for each team, warm-up will consist of 3-3-1.

Placement in the tournament will then be determined by the following criteria:

1. Win-Loss Record

In the event of a two-way tie:

- A. Head to head games
- B. Head to head points - The team that scored the most points within the two games is the higher seed.
- C. Difference in points scored vs. points given up in all pool play games
- D. Coin Flip

In the event of a three-way tie, once one team has been eliminated based on the criteria above, revert back to "A" to break the tie between the two remaining teams.

2. Finish in pool play will determine placement in the pre-determined brackets.
