2. Weight Management Program – 2010-11 booklet posted on NMAA website
3. Classification, Alignment, and Qualifying
 - As approved by Board – June, 2010
 - Adjustments at Class A-3A – if any programs drop out – WSSC recommendation via e-mail, Commission Mtg - 11/17, Board Mtg - 12/2
 - For April meeting – 2 classification proposal (with swimming?)
 - For April meeting – proposal to modify event limits point system?
4. Seeding for district and state tournaments
 - Brief historical review
 - Proposal(s) from Spring, 2010 meeting
 - Proposal tabled, current policy (majority of criteria) remains in effect
5. State Tournament Planning 2010-11
 - Schedule of Events – start 1 hour earlier Friday, finish 1 hour earlier Saturday
 - Future schedule– Schedules with Friday evening semis, a 2 day event schedule and a 3 day event schedule to be proposed in April
 - NWCA Live scoring system – “real time, individual match points” – a lot of planning/personnel, space an issue (extra table at every mat)
 - NMAA updates to website – “bracket updates from bout sheet results” – Corey and Scott to research “Track Wrestling” system
 - Other – voted to drop the coaches breakfast – focus on the event – communicate on wrestling specific issues through the committee
6. Wrestling Officials
 - Assignment, Training, and Fees issues – see NMAA/NMOA documents for policies and procedures on local groups, assignors, assignments, fees.
 - Local group recruitment workshops – further information coming from local groups regarding time/place in each local area
7. NFHS Weight Classes
 - NFHS – Alternatives – Current or Proposal A (which was “B” last spring)
 - Committee voted NMAA vote to NFHS to retain current weights – better fits our population in terms of wrestling population and opportunity to compete
8. School Athletics Equity Act (Title IX)
 - New Mexico law – Data/scrutiny – Title IX
 - Heads up on possibility of cutting or capping boys sports to achieve proportionality
9. Other
 - Corey Anderson to develop a proposal for NMAA regulation/exception to allow coaching out-of-season for NHSCA/other national events, research to include current status of cross country and regional/national events; for review at April meeting (suggestion to share with WSSC and their AD’s prior to meeting for evaluation/endorsement)
