- -Did not take action on an appeal made by Hatch Valley HS, but recommended that the NMAA work with all schools within the Class A-3A Girls Soccer Classification to come up with a plan for district alignment.
- -Voted to continue the allowance given to House HS regarding alternative school enrollment numbers.
- -Voted to deny the appeal presented by Santa Fe Prep

The Board of Directors took action on the following items:

- -Voted to approve the independent baseball co-op request from Santa Fe Prep and Monte del Sol
- -Voted to approve Classification & Alignment for the 2020-2022 block.
