## Adjudicators' Biographies



**Matthew J. Doty (Palisade High School – Palisade, CO)** - Mr. Doty, now in his twentieth year as a Colorado music educator, is currently the Director of Choral Music Activities at Palisade High School in Palisade, Colorado. Mr. Doty has been building the choral music program at Palisade High School for the last six years. Prior to this, Mr. Doty has been the Director of Choral Music Activities at Bookcliff Middle School (Grand Junction), Highlands Ranch High School (Highlands Ranch), and Grand Junction High School (Grand Junction). Mr. Doty has also been a part of the vocal music faculty at Colorado Mesa University. Mr. Doty currently serves as the Chair-Elect of the Vocal Music Council for Colorado Music Educators Association and over the last ten years has served as the Chair and Chair-Elect, Secretary, and the District #7 Representative of the Vocal Music Council for CMEA. Several of Mr. Doty's choirs have either performed or received an invitation to perform at the annual CMEA Conference/Clinic at the Broadmoor Resort in Colorado Springs. He also represents the Western Slope as one of the Western Governors for the Colorado All-State Choir Governing Board and is a vocal judge for the Colorado High School Activities Association Large Group Choral Festivals. An advocate for music literacy within the choral classroom, Mr. Doty has presented sessions on methods and processes of rhythmic and melodic sight-reading for CMEA and Colorado American Choral Directors Association. Mr. Doty holds a Master of Arts Degree in Music Education with a Choral Concentration from the University of St. Thomas (St. Paul, Minnesota) and a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Music - Vocal Performance and Music Theatre from Mesa State College (Colorado Mesa University – Grand Junction, Colorado). He has also completed graduate studies in music education from Colorado State University (Ft. Collins, Colorado) and theatre from Western Illinois University (Macomb, Illinois). When his schedule permits, Mr. Doty enjoys performing or directing and choreographing musicals for various theatrical venues in Grand Junction.



**Richard Gamble (Avon High School – Avon, Indiana)** – Rick Gamble hails originally from Omaha, Nebraska. He makes his home in Avon, Indiana, where he is the Director of Choirs at Avon High School. He administers and/or conducts 8 choirs, produces and directs a musical, directs a madrigal each year, and helps to coordinate the Avon Vocal Invitational. Mr. Gamble is in his 25<sup>th</sup> year of teaching. He has taught at Avon High School for his entire career. Avon is recognized as a NAMM 2015 Best Communities for Music Education District. His choirs have compiled a consistently strong record at state, interstate, and private contests, and have appeared regularly at the Indiana State School Music Association Organizational Finals. This year, he will conduct his choirs in New York City. Mr. Gamble currently serves as the President of the Indiana Choral Directors Association, the state chapter of the American Choral Directors Association (ACDA). Prior to that, as President-Elect, he planned and coordinated two state conferences. He was the ICDA Women's Choirs R & S chair, and served as the ICDA Men's All State Choir Coordinator for seventeen years. He has served on the planning committees of two ADCA Central Division conferences. Mr. Gamble is also an active adjudicator for the Indiana State School Music Association. Before becoming a teacher, Mr. Gamble had an active career as an actor in musical theater. He performed professionally in over a dozen states. Mr. Gamble continued to sing oratorio and pops concerts after beginning his teaching career. He has sung with the professional choral chamber ensemble, Mon Choeur, under the direction of Dr. Paul Krasnovsky, and as a studio musician for the Indianapolis-based Aire Born Group under the direction of Max Murphy. He served as the music director for Meridian Street United Methodist Church in Indianapolis for a number of years. Mr. Gamble received his bachelor and master's degrees in vocal performance from Indiana University, where he studied voice with Walter Cassell, Martha Lipton, and Jean Deis. He was awarded a fellowship from Eli Lilly and Company when he earned his teaching endorsement. Mr. Gamble and his wife, Kelly, have taught together at Avon Schools for over 25 years. They are the proud parents of three children, Meghan, David, and Alyson.

## **Christopher Gravis (California State University–Fullerton and Orange Coast College)-**

American conductor Christopher Gravis has inspired audiences with his masterful interpretations of both choral and orchestral works. Christopher recently made his conducting debut with the San Diego Symphony, and led a week-long residency at St. Paul's Cathedral, London with the Choir of St. Wilfrid of York. At the invitation of Lady Suzi Digby, OBE he participated in research at Cambridge University in the area of early English polyphony. In August of 2015 he returned to England to conduct in residence with the Clarion Singers at Canterbury Cathedral. Future engagements for 2015 | '16 include conducting the LA Schola and the Clarion Singers. As an educator, Mr. Gravis

currently serves as the interim Director of Choral Activities at California State University - Los Angeles, where he conducts ensembles and teaches conducting. He has also served in similar capacities at the University of Southern California, and California State University - Fullerton. He also currently serves on the faculty of Orange Coast College where he conducts the Symphony Orchestra. Christopher has served for six seasons as the Artistic Director of the Orange County Choral Society and Orchestra, where he founded a unique educational program that offers performance opportunities to talented students alongside professional musicians. His innovative programming has drawn wide audience appeal, and he's collaborated with many of the finest musicians around the world. He has prepared choruses for John Williams and the Los Angeles Philharmonic, Keith Lockhart and Boston Pops Esplanade Orchestra, and John Mauceri with the Hollywood Bowl Orchestra. In addition to his professional and academic work, Mr. Gravis has been the Director of Music at St. Wilfrid of York Episcopal Church for the past five years where he has developed a robust choral program in the Anglican cathedral tradition. They are recognized as one the finest sacred music programs in Southern California, and present a full season of musical liturgical services including Choral Evensong and the famous Advent Procession of Lessons & Carols. Also of composer of liturgical music, in May of 2015 the Choir of St. Wilfrid's Episcopal Church premiered Mr. Gravis' new setting of the *Preces & Responses*. Mr. Gravis, a California native, earned a Bachelor of Music degree from the University of Redlands, studied conducting in Salzburg, Austria. He earned a Master of Music degree in Conducting from California State University Fullerton, and is currently Doctoral candidate (ABD) at the University of Southern California Thornton School of Music, where he was a student of Larry Livingston.
