In 2005 Hurst was selected to the prestigious Oklahoma Music Educators Association Hall of Fame. Mr. Hurst has served as clinician and music adjudicator in Oklahoma, Texas, Arkansas, Kansas, Missouri, Colorado, North Dakota and Canada. Offices he has held include President of Oklahoma Bandmasters Association, Vice-President of Oklahoma Music Educators Association, President and Executive Secretary of the Southwestern Oklahoma Band Directors Association, Oklahoma All-State Chairman, President of the El Reno Education Association, El Reno Staff Development Chairman, State Chairman of the National Band Association and was band director of the year by the Southwestern Band Directors Association. He was honored by being chosen as outstanding music educator by the Oklahoma Secondary Schools Association (OSSAA). Mr. Hurst is married to Dr. Terri Hurst, RPh, CCN, who is a registered pharmacist and homeopathic specialist in El Reno. He has children, Melodie, Rustin, Micah as well as three grandchildren, Christian Allen, Jordan Randall, Gavin Mathew and Tylee Lynn.
