Feature: may be news-features (timely nature, but reveal the human side of the news) or be more of a traditional human interest or personality profile.

_____ **Sports Coverage Story:** may be any type of sports news including advance game, issue-oriented or feature.

Editorial: should reflect the conscience of the publication. As such, they should NOT have a byline, but may use the pronoun "we." Facts must be carefully verified by reliable research. Argumentation is important.

Review: presents an evaluation of a CD (album), book, movie, concert, play, restaurant or television program.

Column: These bylined opinion pieces reveal one writer's views. Entries may be by a regular columnist or a one-time opinion piece. They are not editorials (because they are not the staff's opinion). This category includes sports columns.

Cartoon: may be hand drawn or computer generated; All cartoon submissions MUST include the tear sheet from the newspa-

per.

Investigative Reporting: includes investigative reporting on a wide range of topics of current interest to students. Entries should show evidence of thorough and objective research and present a clarifying view, exploring the why's of a problem. Entries can be a single article, a series of articles or a collection of articles on a given topic and may appear in more than one issue.

Sports, Feature and News Photo Contests: should emphasize action and/or show movement. All photo submissions MUST include the tear sheet from the newspaper.

_____ Photo Illustration: The only category of newsroom artwork that permits substantial photo manipulation.

Page One Design: Page should reflect personality of the publication. Readability of the nameplate, use of headline type and packaging of content will be considered.

Package Design: This entry should reflect good use of dominance as well as packaging related items in an attractive manner.

All New Mexico high schools are encouraged to enter the 2017-2018 NMSPA Mail-In Contest. Under our current policy, all schools that produce student publications are members of the NMSPA. Entries must be work completed from April 2016 through March 2018.

DEADLINE: Entries must be postmarked by <u>MAY 31</u> to be included in the contest.

FEES: The entry fee is \$2 per entry for each school.

ENTRIES: Each school may submit an unlimited number of entries per category but only ONE entry per student per category. (For instance, Jessica can enter a story in sports and news but not two sports stories). All music must follow copyright and fair use guidelines.

SUBMISSION FORMAT:

- Export each video entry as a Quicktime file and burn to DVD or copy on a flash drive. Label each entry with: the student's name, school, contest category and a title for the project
- Bundle all contest entries together and place the NMSPA Video Mail-in Contest Entry Form & payment on top

_____ **Feature Video Story:** A feature story that focuses on a person or issue and is more soft news, sports or entertainment in content. It should include b-roll, interviews and appropriate music and sound bites.

_____ Video PSA/Commercial: A public service announcement or commercial created for broadcast that runs between 30-60 seconds. It must include a specific message aimed at a school audience or advertise for a specific product or event.

_____ Documentary: A news story that examines an issue in-depth.
