

NMAA Board of Directors Meeting
Summary
Nov. 10, 2009

The New Mexico Activities Association Board of Directors met today in emergency session to consider the reduction of games beginning with the 2010-2011 school year.

Members of the Board of Directors expressed concern that the reduction of games would result in lost revenue for the overall athletic budgets of member schools.

Board members also stated that the reduction in games would show that the NMAA is attempting to assist with school budgetary concerns and to show the state that schools are willingly to make a reduction because of the economic crisis that our state is experiencing.

A motion was made and approved to table this issue until the December 3, 2009 Board of Director's meeting.

Gary Tripp, NMAA Executive Director, asked that proposals be made to the Commission at their November 18 meeting and ultimately to the Board of Directors on December 3.
