*Schools have claimed to be champions as far back as statehood (1912), first through comparative scores, then by a formula based on record, strength of competition, etc. The Gateway Bowl supposedly matched the two strongest teams in the late 1930s. Later sportswriters and coaches' polls pointed to the best team. But no official championship was organized until 1950 when a new system came into being. The playoffs began in 1953 and have determined the state champions ever since.*
