# Suggested Pre-Game Message That Can Be Read By A Student From Each Team

*PA Announcer: "Fans, please direct your attention to center court for an important announcement from today's teams."* 

(Player 1)

First off, we want to thank you all for being here. We wanted to remind you that Bad Behavior has no place in the game. Let's win with dignity and lose with grace. (Player 2)

Both teams worked hard to get here. We both want to win. Fans, coaches, and players, let's remember to respect the opponent and the officials and Compete with Class.

(Player 1)

Thank you for coming to today's game. Let's make it a memorable experience by Competing with Class.

(Player 2)

That means respecting the opponent and the officials and supporting each team in a positive way. Thank you for helping us Bench Bad Behavior.

(Player 1)

Thank you for coming to this game. We, as players, take care of the action on the court, and your role, as fans, is to support your team and respect the opponent.

(Player 2)

We ask that you cheer in a positive way and respect the officials for the job they do. Together we can Compete with Class.

#### Short Messages That Can Be Read During Breaks in the Action

The NMAA and <u>(*your school*)</u> remind everyone in attendance today to win with grace, lose with dignity, and always Compete with Class.

The NMAA and <u>(*your school*)</u> would like to remind all the fans in attendance to act in a respectful manner. Let's make this a competition we can all be proud of and Compete with Class.

Everyone here today wants their team to win, but remember to be respectful of your opponent and the officials. Let's all remember to Compete with Class.

We would like to remind fans that your behavior can leave a long-lasting impression on how these players remember today's game. Let's help make it a memorable one by Competing with Class.

A reminder to fans, your role is to cheer and support your team, not against your opponent. Together, we can Compete with Class. We would like to encourage the fans to help make this a memorable experience for the players out there on the court/field by supporting them in a respectful manner and remember to Compete with Class.

How you play and act will be more memorable than the final score here today. Be a good sport and always Compete with Class.

The NMAA and <u>(*your school*)</u> would like to remind everyone that players play, coaches coach, officials officiate, and fans cheer. Let's all remember our role and always Compete with Class.

We would like to remind everyone that sportsmanship isn't just a word. Sportsmanship includes our behavior that begins even before the clock starts and continues until the final play. Let's remember to Compete with Class throughout the game.
