- **Officials will be instructed in 3-person officiating mechanics.**
- **Classroom Sessions, Film Breakdown Sessions & Speaker Forums will be included.**
- **This camp is designed to be a high school learning camp, where each official will receive instruction and personal observations that are guaranteed to benefit both new and veteran officials.**
- **Each official will receive credit for attending an NMAA sanctioned 3-person camp.**
- **Basic areas of focus to include Rotations, Switches, Foul Reporting, Primary Areas & Communication.**
- **Advanced areas of focus to include Game Coach and Player Management, Drives to the Basket, Possession consequence and RSBQ plays.**
- **There will be an opportunity to officiate games outside of the Officials Camp and get paid.**
- **The camp has been extended through Sunday for those that can attend on Father's Day. Please do not feel obligated to attend all 3 days. The camp is designed to accommodate everyone for whenever they can attend. Tony will be contacting everyone to confirm the days and times they can attend.**
