NMAA/NMOA TO HOST NATIONAL OFFICIALS SUMMIT

ALBUQUERQUE, NM - The New Mexico Activities Association (NMAA) and New Mexico Officials Association (NMOA) will be hosting the National Association of Sports Officials (NASO) Summit July 26-30 in Albuquerque at the Hyatt Regency Downtown Hotel.

The Summit is the only event of its kind addressing critical topics impacting all aspects of the sports officiating industry. This premier event is held each year in a different location throughout the country during late July or early August. A star studded line-up of speakers and presenters will take the stage in this annual event which brings in over 400 officials from across the country each year. The summit will conclude with the presentation of the prestigious "Gold Whistle Award" which will be given to legendary NBA referee Joey Crawford during Tuesday evening's Officiating Gala.

NMAA Deputy Director and Commissioner of Officials Dana Pappas stated: "Being able to host the NASO Summit is truly an honor. This is the largest summit for officials in the nation and will provide a fantastic opportunity for professional development and education for officials in the Land of Enchantment."
