**Student Eligibility: Exception for Out-of-State Transfer** - Ms. Marquez presented a proposal stating on emergency basis for the 2020-2021 school year and due to the coronavirus pandemic, consider adding the following to number 7 within the NMAA handbook addendum for COVID-19; New Mexico Students who transfer and participate in interscholastic athletics at an out of state school during the 2020-2021 school year shall not be subject to transfer penalties during the 2021-2022 school year provided those students return to their initial school. Students who choose to remain out of state and participate in interscholastic athletics during the 2021-2022 school year shall not be provided this exception. \*Note: NMAA Bylaw 6.13.1 B shall remain in effect and students who start a season out of state shall not be eligible to return to New Mexico and participate in that same sport during the same school year. **Scholastic Eligibility: 6-Week Grades** - Ms. Marquez presented a proposal that on an emergency and temporary basis for the spring semester of the 2020-2021 school year and due to the COVID-19 pandemic, consider adjusting the COVID Handbook Addendum 5.c- Scholastic Eligibility to include allowing a Student who is scholastically ineligible after the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the 2020-2021 school year, and is unable to utilize the cumulative provision and/or appeals process, is subject to the following guidelines for regaining eligibility and retaining eligibility for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year: A student may regain his/her eligibility at the next regular grading period (3<sup>rd</sup> quarter or 4<sup>th</sup> 6-weeks). If the school's next regular grading period is the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter, a Student may regain his/her eligibility at the 6 weeks by utilizing a progress report. A student on a 6-week grading period who regains/maintains eligibility after the 5<sup>th</sup> 6-weeks will retain his/her eligibility for the remainder of the 2020-2021 competition calendar; and a Student who is ineligible at the conclusion of the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter or 5<sup>th</sup> 6-weeks will remain ineligible for the remainder of the 2020-2021 competition calendar. #### **Proposal:**

On an emergency and temporary basis for the spring semester of the 2020-2021 school year only and due to the COVID-19 pandemic, consider the following:

Provide an exception to NMAA Bylaws 7.5.3.F (Summer Activity) and 7.15.1.B.4 & 9.8.4.A.4 (Football Practice Regulations) so that football helmets and shoulder pads can be used during offseason workouts.

This exception would ONLY apply for the period beginning February 1, 2021, through the first official day of practice for the 2021 Spring Semester football season. All athletes must first participate in a minimum of two (2) days of practice with helmets only prior to working out in shells (helmets and shoulder pads); shells can be worn beginning day three of practice at the earliest.

Full contact / Live Action drills are prohibited during these offseason workouts. In addition, all NMAA/COVID-19 Return to Play Guidelines must be followed.

If a school opts to use helmets and shoulder pads during this time, the initial 4-day acclimation period (2-days in helmets, 2-days in helmets and shoulder pads) required prior to moving in to full pads during Week 1 of official practice will be waived. Note that this acclimation period would still apply for athletes who did not participate in offseason workouts or did not fulfill 2 days in helmets and 2 days in shells.

The NMAA will provide full information regarding practice regulations for the official season in its Football Guidelines which will outline modifications due to COVID-19.

#### **Rationale:**

Provide more time for student-athletes to acclimate to football equipment as schools prepare for a condensed football season.
