However, per a recent request from the Navajo Nation that Wingate students not participate in athletics, Mr. Martinez withdrew his request. Proposal:

Sites for State Soccer Playoffs – 1st Round, Quarterfinals, Semifinals

Beginning with the 2021-2022 school year, utilize host school sites (higher seed) for the State Soccer Championships during the 1st Round, Quarterfinals, and Semifinals. Only the Finals would be held at a centralized location for all classifications (boys & girls).

Rationale:

The NMAA received positive feedback from the Soccer community regarding the format used for the State Tournament during this unique school year where early round match-ups were played at host school sites. This allowed for communities across the state to experience state playoff matches while also cutting down on expenses for some schools that travel from outlying areas of the state for the quarterfinals & semifinals typically held in the Albuquerque area.

Soccer Survey Results:

Athletic Directors: 35-13 in favor of using host school sites (73%)

Coaches: 74-23 in favor of using host school sites (76%)

- Current: Bylaw 7.14.2 C Teams are allowed to enter a maximum of nine (9) runners in the District Meet (only). At all other varsity meets, teams are limited to seven (7) runners.)
- **Proposal:** Teams are allowed to enter a maximum of nine (9) runners in the Pre-State and District Meet (only).
- **Rationale:** This will allow varsity teams to enter two (2) additional runners for the Pre-State varsity meet allowing their potential alternate runners to race on the state course prior to the state meet.

Proposal/Rationale:

The purpose of the proposal is to require NMAA varsity head football coaches to submit film to a film repository hosted by the NMAA office on Hudl. The purpose of the film submission is an avenue for the evaluation of officials and for the continued training and education of the NMOA football staff.

- All NMAA varsity head football coaches will have Hudl accounts provided on the NMOA Football Hudl. Coaches can use the platform to exchange film between one another if they so choose but the intent of the account is for internal use by the NMAA/NMOA staff and the officials. These accounts will be covered on the NMAA license and will not create a financial burden on the individual schools/coaches.
- Coaches will be required to submit Varsity game film to the NMOA Football Hudl account each week of the season. Film can be raw game footage and need not be clipped.
 - Thursday games film must be submitted by 1:00 p.m. on Saturday
 - Friday games film must be submitted by 1:00 p.m. on Saturday
 - Saturday games film must be submitted by 10:00 a.m. on Sunday
- If a coach has questions or concerns about a specific play, the play(s) should be flagged within Hudl with an email to the NMAA office (<u>danamarie@nmact.org</u>), describing the concern and asking for a response. The email should include the clip number and any rules reference that pertains to the clip.

Note that all football coaches in the state were contacted by Coach Giles and approximately 85% of the coaches were in favor of this proposal.

Proposal: Consider amending the calendar (Bylaw 7.15.6 – Playoff Weeks) for Class 2A Football so that brackets for the state tournament are released at the same time as Class 3A-6A (Saturday of Week #18). Currently, the Class 2A brackets are released on the Saturday of Week #17.

Rationale:

Several 2A Football Coaches approached the NMAA after the conclusion of the 2019 season asking for their bracket to be released at the same time as all other 11-man football classes (3A-6A). The main reason for this would be to ensure that the wins vs. district champion criteria point can be used for Class 2A schools that play games versus schools in a higher classification. Although schedules have already been finalized for 2020-2021, 2A coaches felt that an easy solution would be that all schools within the classification have an open week after their last regular season game.
