*Upon direction of the Board of Directors, the New Mexico Activities Association is asking member schools that participate in the **sport of tennis** to vote on the issue below. Please read through the entire referendum before selecting your response. Thank you for your participation in the governance of your organization and for your support of interscholastic activities.*

Tennis District Team Championship Scoring Format

This proposed scoring modification would shorten matches once a team reaches 5 points but would still provide opportunity for all players on a team to compete. The process would be as follows:

1. In districts where the district champion is determined based on head-to-head 9-point matches (6 singles and 3 doubles) between district teams, the match must be played to the full 9 points. By agreement of the match coaches, or by district tennis rule determination, once a team has reached 5 points using regular scoring as required in 7.21.2.B2, the scoring for the remainder of the matches may be modified.
2. In districts where the district champion is based on a year-end district team tournament, district tournament matches are ended when one team earns 5 points in the 9-point format, using regular scoring as required in 7.21.2.B2.
