Executive Director Sally Marquez gave her Director's Report which included information on the upcoming Winter Championships and an update regarding the current legislative session.

-Voted to table a proposal to adjust Bylaw 13.2.2 (Right of Appeal).

-Voted in favor of a proposal that addresses student transfers after participation in the tryout period (Bylaw 6.13.1.D).

-Voted in favor of a proposal to amend Bylaw 9.3.1.H (8th grade participation)

-Took the following action regarding classification & alignment for the 2018-19/2019-20 block: Voted in favor of a proposal to move from six to five classes Voted in favor of a proposal to use an 80-80-40 three-year average enrollment count Voted in favor of a proposal to use enrollment breaks (hard numbers) to classify schools Voted to table a proposal to use a conference model instead of districts
