NMAA Board of Directors' Summary



February 29, 2012

The NMAA Board of Directors met in special session today, via teleconference.

The Board of Directors tabled an action item that would have allowed private schools in New Mexico to play up in classification, in select sports/ programs, for the 2012-2013, 2013-2014 school years. The Board of Directors asked the NMAA staff to bring the issue of alignment and classification for the next alignment block (beginning with the 2014-2015 school year) to the June 7 Board of Directors' meeting.

The Board of Directors approved a referenda to consider adding the chairperson of the middle school committee as a representative to the NMAA Commission. This referenda will be sent to the NMAA membership following the 2012 State Basketball Championships.

The Football Sports Specific Committee requested that the Board of Directors consider increasing the number of Class 2A football playoff teams from 8 to 12 teams and decrease the number of Class 3A football playoff teams from 12 to 8 teams. The Board of Directors voted to approve the increase in 2A to 12 teams, while they voted against any decrease in Class 3A football playoff teams.
