

NMAA Board of Directors Summary

September 21, 2011



The NMAA Board of Directors met in regular session today at the New Mexico Activities Association.

The NMAA staff will issue two referendums to the membership of the NMAA, which will be due on Oct. 7th. The first referenda will seek to revise NMAA bylaw 6.8 (Conditions of Guardianship), while the second referenda will request a change to the process by which changes are made to the NMAA handbook (bylaw 2.7).

The Board of Directors voted not to eliminate Eight-Man football at this time. The Board asked the NMAA staff to continue to evaluate this topic as it prepares the classifications of football for the next alignment and classification block beginning with the 2014-2015 school year.

The Board of Directors voted to approve Santa Fe High School's appeal to remain in Class 4A for the remainder of the current alignment and classification block.

The Board of Directors voted to approve the district alignments for the 2012-2013, 2013-2014 alignment, with the addition of a 5th district in class 2A football.

The Board of Directors voted to approve Show Choir State Competition beginning with the 2011-2012 school year.

NMAA staff presented information as discussion items pertaining to the next alignment and classification block beginning with the 2014-2015 school year, bylaw 7.4.5 (open Gymnasium and Facility) and the Board of Directors goals for the 2011-2012 school year.

The next Board of Directors meeting will be held on December 1, 2011.
