The NMAA Board of Directors met in regular session today at the New Mexico Activities Association.

The Board took action on three of eight general action items during the meeting; the other items were tabled until the March 7, 2012 meeting.

The Board voted to issue a referenda to the membership of the NMAA to have $8^{\text {th }}$ grade participants at the high school level submit written parental permission to the NMAA prior to participation. The referenda will be sent out on Monday, December 5, 2011.

The Board approved a proposal to adjust the districts and classifications for Six-Man and Eight-Man football for the 2012 and 2013 seasons. The new districts are as follows:

The Board also approved an adjustment to the number of qualifiers in the Class 3A state wrestling tournament. District 1 and 2 will each have 4 state qualifiers, while district $3 / 4$ will have 2 qualifiers; a total of 10 qualifiers.

The Board did table the following proposals to allow the NMAA staff to gather more information and/or support material:

- Eliminate Bylaw 6.7 (Boarding School Student) beginning in 2012-13.
- Pre-season tournaments and/or pre-season camps/tryout camps are not allowed 21 days prior to the season beginning, effective immediately.
- Pojoaque district alignment appeal for 2012-2013, 2013-2014 school years.
- NMMI classification appeal for the 2012-2013, 2013-2014 school years.
- Consider the addition of middle schools to the NMAA website for SAEA reporting at a cost of $\$ 600$ per month.

The next Board meeting will be held March 7, 2012 at The Pit, in conjunction with the 2012 State Basketball Championships.
