DISTRICT INDIVIDUALWRESTLING TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES – 2021-2022



SCHEDULE/ENTRIES

- 1. District specific information will come from your district chairs/tournament hosts.
- Official entries must be submitted via Trackwrestling (TW) no later than Tuesday the week of the district tournament (February 8, 2022). Entries shall be submitted directly into the tournament via the green envelope next to the event listed in each team's TW season (Boys/Girls) schedule page.
- 3. During the roster entry period, host schools will lose administrative access to TW from 8:00PM Monday, February 7 thru 9:00AM Wednesday, February 9.
- 4. Weight classes may not be changed after rosters are submitted. Teams may replace a wrestler who is forced to withdraw after the submission deadline but only at the same weight class and only by a wrestler not already entered at another weight class.
- 5. Any team failing to submit complete and correct entries with complete and accurate individual records by the deadline will be subject to a \$250 fine.
- 6. Entries will be considered verified at the conclusion of the weigh-in. Entries failing to make weight will be scratched and ineligible for a wild card. Additionally, any bracket drawn prior to the weigh-in with scratched wrestlers will need to be redrawn.
- Entries must be in accordance with NWCA OPC MWW/MWC and 33% of season weigh-ins must be at or below the weight entered for the district tournament. Coaches must be prepared to verify each of their entries' seasonal weigh-in records.

EVENT PLANNING

- 1. The district-wrestling tournament is to be held in week #33, February 10-12, 2022.
- 2. The individual district tournament does not count against the NMAA event limit.
- 3. Trackwrestling shall determine the seeds in each weight class see 2022 state seeding document.
- 4. Team scores determine district placement in the Girls' division.
- 5. You may want to consult with wrestling officials' assignors in areas where multiple district tournaments scheduled at the same time/day might create a shortage of officials.
- 6. The NMAA handbook sets district match fees for officials at \$4.50/match.
- 7. It is the discretion of the district to charge admission; if admission is charged; max price is set at \$5.
- 8. District make-up and state qualifiers see "Class/Align/Qualify" document.

TRACKWRESTLING (TW)

- 1. TW (<u>www.trackwrestling.com</u>) is the approved software for the district tournament. All communication regarding TW software will be communicated by TW representatives directly to the assigned host school head coach.
- 2. Format for the district tournament will be consistent with the state tournament, modified double elimination bracket (no round robins, no "true seconds", no extra placing matches, etc.).
- 3. Brackets will be provided by TW. Event directors should select the bracket which corresponds to the number of entries in each weight class (failure to select the correct brackets will affect team scores).
- 4. Seeding System Instructions:
 - I. Match Wrestlers to the Dual System click the following
 - a. [Set-Up], [Wrestlers], [Match to Dual System] Type match
 - i. Wrestlers who are incorrectly matched will need to be matched properly by clicking [Get]. The head coach will assist with matching the correct wrestler (disregard "unknowns" if you haven't already removed them).
 - II. Seeding Click the following
 - a. [Bracketing], [Seed/Build Brackets]
 - b. For each weight class, click all participants and then click [Fetch Criteria]
 - c. To view the seed report, click all participants and then click [View NMAA Seed Report]

RE: TRACKWRESTLING INDIVIDUAL RECORDS & DISTRICT/STATE SEEDING

District/State seeding will be conducted via Trackwrestling. This is a reminder you will need to submit district tournament rosters with complete and accurate varsity individual results for all district tournament entries. The district event will be added to your schedules and you will submit your rosters using the green envelope icon next to the event. It is your responsibility to ensure the weight class, record and matches you submit at the district tournament are accurate for every entry.

To check your individual records for accuracy:

- 1. Log into your Boys and/or Girls TW Season
- 2. Go to [Matches] and select [Print Matches] for each individual wrestler to review their matches
- 3. ONLY VARSITY MATCHES SHOULD BE ON THE RECORD YOU SUBMIT INTO THE DISTRICT TOURNAMENT
- 4. Make sure all varsity matches are labeled "varsity"
- 5. Make sure there are no duplicates, omissions or inaccuracies in your varsity individual records
- 6. Any errors need to be fixed inside your schedules and any individual records updated

To check returning 2021 state placing criteria:

- 1. Log into your TW account
- 2. Go to [Roster]
- 3. Select returning 2021 state placers
- 4. Click on [Criteria Values]
- 5. Contact me if wrestlers are missing or have incorrect 2021 state placing

*NOTE – Make sure you are staying on top of your records. Any teams failing to submit complete and correct district rosters by the deadline (Tuesday, February 8th) or submitting rosters with inaccurate varsity records/results will be subject to a \$250 fine.

Memorandum

RE: QUALIFYING AND SEEDING – DISTRICT & STATE WRESTLING

A few guidelines and expectations applicable to district and state tournaments. These guidelines are applicable to both male and female competitors unless otherwise noted.

1. Overall Record Guidelines:

- For male competitors, all varsity level matches in all weight classes are included.
- For female competitors, only official matches against other female competitors, in any weight class or level, are included.
- Matches won by decision, major decision, technical fall, fall, forfeit, disqualification, or default shall be counted as wins.
- Matches where an individual loses by decision, major decision, technical fall, fall, forfeit, disqualification, or default shall be counted as losses. (The NMAA does not recognize medical forfeits. Any losses marked as a medical forfeit must be updated to a regular forfeit.)
- Individual tournament forfeits will not count toward the head-to-head or common opponent seeding criteria.
- Since the actual entry of an athlete in a dual meet does not occur until properly reporting to the scorer's table, an athlete not making weight would not incur a loss for a dual meet.
- If a verified entry in an individual tournament fails to appear or make weight, they would incur two losses in a double elimination tournament. If no stipulated deadline for entries was pre-determined, the deadline shall be the completion of weigh-ins.
- Since non-school events are generally not conducted under NFHS/NMAA guidelines, those individual results would not be included in the overall record (note these events are subject to event limits under the dual participation rule).

2. Documentation:

- Out-of-state state place winners that can be documented are recognized.
- Detailed individual cumulative records and weigh-in records must be available for submission upon request from the NMAA for the entry/seeding process. Individual records must be maintained via Trackwrestling (see NMAA TW Admin Instructions on NMAA wrestling website – <u>www.nmact.org/wrestling</u>)

3. Ethics and Gamesmanship:

- The submission of inaccurate records or failing to comply with WWMP policies, including the 33% of weigh-ins rule, would be the equivalent of submitting false times/distances in track and field or swimming.
- Coaches should be working cooperatively in the monitoring of the WWMP, weigh-ins, and documentation so that all records and weigh-ins are in compliance prior to entries for the district tournament.
- It would be gamesmanship and therefore unethical behavior to knowingly wait to question an opponent's record or weight management program status until it was too late to rectify it. The appropriate thing to do is to bring any suspected issues up with the opponent immediately upon discovery or suspicion.

SEEDING FOR 2022 NMAA STATE WRESTLING TOURNAMENT

DISTRICT MEETINGS

Meetings of wrestling coaches within each district are held prior to the state seeding meeting:

- 1. Designate representatives to the state seeding committee. Representatives are selected based
 - on the results of the district dual meets. The coaches of the championship team and runnerup team shall be the representatives.
- 2. Verify varsity records and results for state qualifying athletes.

STATE MEETING

A seeding meeting via web conference call is conducted under the direction and supervision of the NMAA on Monday preceding the State Tournament. Seeding is overseen by a **committee** composed of district representatives. The tournament director (authorized by NMAA) may appoint others to assist with the process as necessary. Entries shall be considered verified at the conclusion of each classification's seeding meeting.

SEEDING PROCESS

- A. Eight individuals are seeded in each weight class in 5A and 4A, four in A-3A and Girls.
- B. Trackwrestling software will be used to seed all weight classes.
- C. NMAA Wrestling Seeding Rules are as follows:
 - 1. All wrestlers with a .500 record or better are considered for a seed.
 - 2. Schools wishing for wrestlers below .500 to be considered for a seed must request inclusion in the seeding process prior to running the seeding report.
 - 3. Criteria points are earned against all wrestlers considered for a seed in the following priority order:
 - a. Head-to-head (H2H) results
 - b. Records against common opponents
 - c. Returning state place (previous year state tournament only)
 - d. Best overall percentage record (Boys must have wrestled a minimum of sixteen (16) varsity matches this season; record to include all varsity matches in all weights. Girls must have wrestled ten (10) official matches against other female competitors this season; record to include all official matches against other female competitors in all weights.)
 - 4. The wrestler with the most "points" earns the one seed. The wrestler with the second most points earns the two seed, etc.
 - 5. Tie breaking procedures are as follows:
 - a. If two individuals are tied on points they will be compared alone and awarded seeds based on the priority criteria procedure listed above.

b. If three or more individuals are tied on points they will be compared alone and awarded seeds first using H2H (must have winning record over all opponents to be considered) followed by returning state place and then best overall percentage record if a tie is not broken by returning state place.

c. If three or more individuals remain tied the seeding committee shall vote on the order of seeds. In case of a tie vote, the seeds are determined by a coin toss or draw of lots.
